**Disappointment Tries Perseverance**

Some years ago at a youth ministry gathering in the diocese, a young woman rose to make an address before her colleagues. She presented her experience of prayer and gave a new look to an old saying; namely, what we propose, God disposes. She had set herself on one path and just when she was at a critical juncture in her progress toward her goal, she lost her chance to fulfill her dreams. She belonged to a championship basketball team and was on her way to the game that would determine their dominance when she was severely injured in a car accident and raced immediately to the hospital.

Her recovery was slow and painful. What she could normally do with great ease became an ordeal. She had to learn how to keep her balance and hopefully learn to walk again on her own. She had to reorient her life, slow down, and she had the emotional struggle of losing what was her lifelong dream to pursue her talent as a basketball champion. (Continued on page 5...)

Tuvo que reorientar su vida, reducir la velocidad, y tuvo la lucha emocional de perder lo que era el sueño de toda su vida de perseguir su talento como campeona de baloncesto. After an arduous and painful recovery, she began to feel as she did previous to the accident making easy progress in daily routines that became more and more productive. She had her life back.

As a result of all this, Sr. Jody now follows a vocation as a professed member of the Oakford Dominican Sister. During her recovery she realized the vocation to which God was calling her. She may have had her hopes and dreams dashed; she may have been truly disappointed. Still while much of the energy she put into her dreams was shattered, she was able to pick up the pieces and reforge them into a quest that led her to the decision to follow a vocation to which God had called her. This is the story of how people take life’s disappointments and learn to persevere through them.

Becoming a Dominican Sister may not have been what she imagined she would become, and she shares a similar story to Catholic Saints throughout history. In one of his most recent books, “The Road to Character,” David Brooks cites a passage from Victor Frankl’s “Man’s Search for Meaning.” He quotes, “It did not really matter what we expected from life, but rather what life expected from us.” From that line, Brooks reckons that “fate had put a moral task and an intellectual task before him. It had given him an assignment.”

Life is full of disappointments, and our assignment is to see the good even the worst situations. When we are grateful for our life and the opportunity for years of service to our community, it’s then that we can persevere through disappointment.

*Luego de una ardua y dolorosa recuperación, comenzó a sentirse como antes del accidente, avanzando con facilidad en las rutinas diarias que se hacían cada vez más productivas. Ella recuperó su vida.*

*Como resultado de todo esto, la Hna. Jody ahora sigue una vocación como miembro de las Hermanas Dominicanas de Oakford. Durante su recuperación se dio cuenta de la vocación a la que Dios la estaba llamando. Es posible que sus esperanzas y sueños se hayan desvanecido; ella puede haber estado realmente decepcionada. Aún así, aunque gran parte de la energía que puso en sus sueños se habían destrozado, pudo recoger los pedazos y reconstruirlos en una búsqueda que la llevó a la decisión de seguir una vocación a la que Dios la había llamado. Esta es la historia de cómo personas toman las decepciones de la vida y aprenden a perseverar a través de ellas.*

*Convertirse en una hermana dominica puede no haber sido lo que ella imaginó que se volviera, y comparte una historia similar con los santos católicos a lo largo de la historia. En uno de sus libros más recientes, “El camino hacia el carácter”, David Brooks cita un pasaje de “El hombre en busca de sentido” de Victor Frankl. Él cita: “Realmente no importaba lo que esperábamos de la vida, sino lo que la vida esperaba de nosotros”. En esa línea, Brooks cuenta que “el destino le había puesto delante una tarea moral y una tarea intelectual. Le había dado esa tarea.”*

*La vida está llena de decepciones, y nuestra tarea es ver lo bueno incluso en las peores situaciones. Cuando estamos agradecidos por nuestra vida y la oportunidad de años de servicio a nuestra comunidad, es entonces cuando podemos perseverar a través de la decepción.*



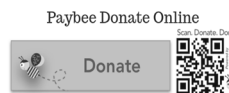

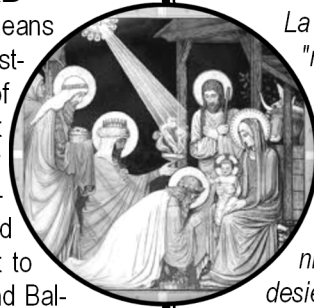


# Children & Teen Faith Formation

## Formación de Fe para Niños y Adolescentes

### THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

The word 'Epiphany' comes from Greek and means 'manifestation'. Epiphany, or the 12th day of Christmas, falls on January 6 and marks the last day of the Christmas season. The Twelfth Night (Epiphany) also marks a visit to the baby Jesus by The Magi, (the three Kings, or Wise Men). According to the Gospel of Matthew, the three kings found baby Jesus by following a star across the desert to Bethlehem. The three kings: Melchior, Caspar and Baltazar, followed the star to meet the baby Jesus, and offer Him symbolic gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.



Across the world, the day's festivities vary. In the Spanish speaking world Epiphany is known as Dia de los Reyes (Three Kings' Day) In Mexico, for instance, families gather to taste the Rosca de Reyes (Kings' bread) where a Jesus figurine is hidden in the bread. Whoever finds the small baby Jesus hidden inside their slice of the Rosca de Reyes throws a party on Candlemas, February 2nd. In some European and Latin-American countries, children leave their shoes out the night before to be filled with gifts, while others leave straw for the three Kings' horses. The Catholic dioceses in the US mark the Epiphany feast on the Sunday after January 6.

### LA EPIFANIA DEL SEÑOR

La palabra "Epifanía" viene del griego y significa "manifestación". Epifanía, o el 12º día de Navidad, cae el 6 de enero y marca el último día de la temporada de Navidad. La Duodécima Noche (Epifanía) también marca una visita al Niño Jesús por los Magos, (los tres Reyes o Sabios). Según el Evangelio de Mateo, los tres reyes encontraron al niño Jesús siguiendo una estrella a través del desierto a Belén. Los tres reyes: Melchor, Gaspar y Baltazar, siguieron la estrella para encontrar al niño Jesús, y le ofrecieron regalos simbólicos de oro, incienso y mirra.

En todo el mundo varían las festividades de este día. En el mundo de habla española, la Epifanía es conocida como Día de los Reyes Magos. En México, por ejemplo, las familias se reúnen para comer la Rosca de Reyes, donde una figura de Jesús está escondida en el pan. Quien encuentra al bebé Jesús escondido dentro de su trozo de la Rosca de Reyes hace una fiesta en el día de la Candelaria, el 2 de febrero. En algunos países europeos y latinoamericanos, los niños dejan sus zapatos la noche anterior para ser llenados de regalos, mientras que otros dejan paja para los caballos de los tres reyes. Las diócesis católicas de los Estados Unidos celebran la fiesta de la Epifanía el domingo después del 6 de enero.

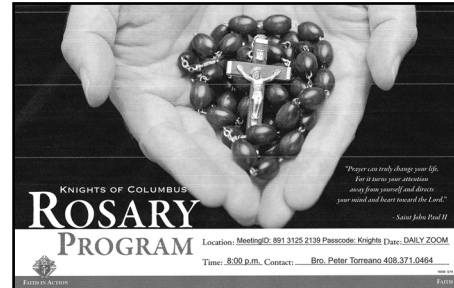
