A Spirit of Simplicity

People reflect on simplicity as an alternative way of life in an otherwise complicated world. Last I checked there is a magazine titled "Real Simple" that is dedicated to simplifying life. There is stark irony with an attempt to simplify one's life by way of material goods in a complex social setting. It seems that simplicity is reduced to a matter of good taste or building a better mousetrap. Even this analysis—skeptical as it may be—makes simplicity complex.

The lyric to the Donovan song used in the film "Brother Sun Sister Moon" evokes the kind of Franciscan simplicity that many seek as a genuine approach to God. "If you want to live life free, take your time, go slowly. Do few things but do them well, simple joys are holy." There are many that would like to make this form of simplicity a regular practice in life, and some do it successfully. (Continued on page 5...)



Un Espíritu de Sencillez

La gente reflexiona sobre la simplicidad como una forma de vida alternativa en un mundo por lo demás complicado. La última vez que me fije hay una revista titulada "Real Simple" que se dedica a simplificar la vida. Existe una gran ironía en el intento de simplificar la vida de uno mediante bienes materiales en un entorno social complejo. Parece que la sencillez se reduce a una cuestión de buen gusto o de construir una mejor ratonera. Incluso este análisis, por escéptico que sea, hace que la simplicidad sea compleja.

La letra de la canción de Donovan utilizada en la película "Hermano Sol, Hermana Luna" evoca el tipo de sencillez franciscana que muchos buscan como un acercamiento genuino a Dios. "Si quieres vivir una vida libre, tómate tu tiempo, ve despacio. Haz pocas cosas pero hazlas bien, las alegrías simples son sagradas". Hay muchos que quisieran hacer de esta forma de simplicidad una práctica regular en la vida, y algunos lo hacen con éxito. (Continúa en la página 5...)



BAPTISMAL DEATH AND RESURRECTION

As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we also honor our own baptism as our initiation into the Christian life and community. In the Gospel, the baptism of Jesus, with his immersion and then emergence from the water, points to his later submission to God at his death, and his emergence from the grave at his resurrection. This pattern of death and resurrection is our path too, as followers of Jesus. Throughout life, often in small ways, we learn to surrender our limited and self-centered agendas. This surrender often feels like death. The sacrament of Baptism ritually enacts this pattern to remind us of Jesus' death and resurrection, so that we too might embrace the deaths and resurrections of our own lives. As Jesus emerged from the water, he encountered his Father and the Holy Spirit. Like Jesus, we can know we are God's beloved, empowered by the Spirit. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.



MUERTE Y RESURRECCIÓN BAUTISMAL

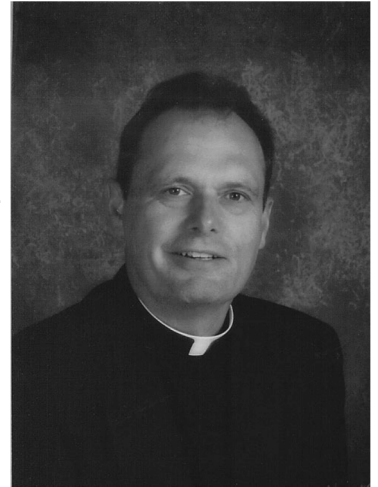
A medida que celebramos el Bautismo del Señor, también honramos nuestro propio bautismo como nuestra iniciación en la vida y comunidad cristiana. En el Evangelio, el bautismo de Jesús, con su inmersión y posterior salida del agua, indica su posterior entrega a Dios en su muerte, y su salida del sepulcro en su resurrección. Como seguidores de Jesús, esta forma de muerte y resurrección también es nuestro camino. A lo largo de la vida, y a menudo de manera limitada, aprendemos a renunciar a nuestros planes egoístas y limitados. Esta renuncia a menudo se siente como la muerte. El Sacramento del Bautismo ritualmente representa este camino para recordarnos la muerte y resurrección de Jesús, para que nosotros también podamos aceptar las muertes y resurrecciones de nuestras propias vidas. Cuando Jesús salió del agua, se encontró con su Padre y el Espíritu Santo. Como Jesús, podemos saber que somos los amados de Dios, fortalecidos por el Espíritu.

Even while this may be true for some more than others, everyone faces some form of complexity. Whether these are moral or relational dilemmas, conflicts over power or wealth, or struggles to survive, all of us do well to realize that each day presents new opportunities for finding a simple path to God and others. We can hold onto to principles that will assist with the day-to-day, though we are often stymied by the unexpected. How ought we approach the unexpected in way that leads us to greater simplicity?

As with all events in life, we depend upon the grace of God. We are not always aware of this grace, so we do well to bring our concern to prayer, to listen to others' counsel, and seek God's providence. We cannot expect simplicity to come with immediacy, and if we are wise, we will wait for the answer. While it's not uncommon to find people who lose patience waiting for answers, some crises require immediate action. Saving lives will top the list of any action plan, and thanks be to God there are those especially suited to work through chaos and bring order by a simple approach to a complex crisis.

Normally, we are not stressed by crisis all the time, and this gives opportunity to seek a direction that will help us lead fruitful and meaningful lives. As the lyric goes—"take your time go slowly". Such a simply way allows us to live in the present and acknowledge God's grace abounds. Conflict, suffering, surviving may well make our lives more complex. Still, we will not be well if we fail to see how God's grace is at work in us. A simple approach to life is the best way to live.

Aunque esto puede ser cierto para algunos más que para otros, todos enfrentan algún tipo de complejidad. Ya sea que se trate de dilemas morales o relacionales, conflictos por el poder o la riqueza, o luchas por sobrevivir, todos hacemos bien en darnos cuenta de que cada día presenta nuevas oportunidades para encontrar un camino sencillo hacia Dios y hacia los demás. Podemos aferrarnos a principios que nos ayudarán en el día a día, aunque a menudo nos vemos obstaculizados por lo inesperado. ¿Cómo debemos abordar lo inesperado de una manera que nos lleve a una mayor simplicidad?

Como ocurre con todos los eventos de la vida, dependemos de la gracia de Dios. No siempre somos conscientes de esta gracia, por lo que hacemos bien en llevar nuestra preocupación a la oración, escuchar los consejos de los demás y buscar la providencia de Dios. No podemos esperar que la simplicidad venga con inmediatez, y si somos sabios, esperaremos la respuesta. Aunque no es raro encontrar personas que pierden la paciencia esperando respuestas, algunas crisis requieren una acción inmediata. Salvar vidas encabezará la lista de cualquier plan de acción y, gracias a Dios, hay quienes están especialmente capacitados para superar el caos y poner orden mediante un enfoque simple en una crisis compleja.

Normalmente, las crisis no nos estresan todo el tiempo, y esto nos da la oportunidad de buscar una dirección que nos ayude a llevar una vida fructífera y significativa. Como dice la letra: "tómame tu tiempo, ve despacio". Una forma tan sencilla nos permite vivir en el presente y reconocer la abundancia de la gracia de Dios. El conflicto, el sufrimiento, la supervivencia pueden hacer que nuestras vidas sean más complejas. Aún así, no estaremos bien si no vemos cómo la gracia de Dios obra en nosotros. Un enfoque simple de la vida es la mejor manera de vivir.

THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD

Last Monday, January 8th, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of the Baptism of Our Lord. This brought to an end the season of Christmas. The Church recalls Our Lord's second manifestation or epiphany which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan. Jesus descended into the River to sanctify its waters and to give them the power to beget sons of God. The event takes on the importance of a second creation in which the entire Trinity intervenes.

Many of the incidents which accompanied Christ's baptism are symbolical of what happened at our Baptism. At Christ's baptism the Holy Spirit descended upon Him; at our Baptism the Trinity took its abode in our soul. At His baptism Christ was proclaimed the "Beloved Son" of the Father; at our Baptism we become the adopted sons of God. At Christ's baptism the heavens were opened; at our Baptism heaven was opened to us.



EL BAUTISMO DE NUESTRO SEÑOR

El pasado lunes 8 de enero, la Iglesia celebró la Solemnidad del Bautismo de Nuestro Señor. Esto puso fin a la temporada de Navidad. La Iglesia recuerda la segunda manifestación o epifanía de Nuestro Señor que ocurrió con motivo de su bautismo en el Jordán. Jesús descendió al río para santificar sus aguas y darles el poder de engendrar hijos de Dios. El acontecimiento adquiere la importancia de una segunda creación en la que interviene toda la Trinidad.

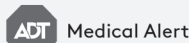
