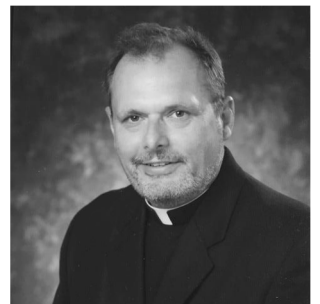

With all the advice there is, the subjectivity of our taste for food is a matter too difficult to discern and reduce to a universal measure of what is healthy, nutritious, or for that matter necessary. What’s lacking in many of these programs is a palatable menu of food. A menu described as healthy seems to grate on the subjective sensibility of taste as most diet and exercise programs offer what might otherwise be loosely described as chalk or cardboard.



To order a kitchen, the cook must have in mind what is available to cook and form into a balance of micronutrients, carbohydrate, protein, and fat. These are basic for what humans need daily for good health—in the right balance and portion. Additionally, the cook does well to prepare the meal to make the food safe to eat. This is the reason cooking started in the first place. That we yearn for a well-cooked meal is no surprise, it’s just that we so often don’t know how to imagine our own menu when there are too many choices. How to balance taste and nutrition corresponds with a regular exercise regimen that keeps one fit and ready each day.

This might seem like basic stuff and it is, but balancing our lives requires patience with the things we don’t do well and zeal for the things we’ve mastered. Each Sunday we receive the grace of Christ’s Body and Blood so that we can become what we receive and learn to love as Christ loves, forgive as Christ forgives, and heal as Christ heals. These actions flow from the very familiar actions that lend to a healthy lifestyle, so naturally the good news is what we both receive and proclaim in a healthy balance of prayer and service.

Con todos los consejos que existen, la subjetividad de nuestro gusto por la comida es un asunto demasiado difícil de discernir y reducir a una medida universal de lo que es saludable, nutritivo o, por lo demás, necesario. Lo que falta en muchos de estos programas es un menú sabroso de comida. Un menú descrito como saludable parece irritar la sensibilidad subjetiva del gusto, ya que la mayoría de los programas de dieta y ejercicio ofrecen lo que de otro modo podría describirse vagamente como tiza o cartón.



Para ordenar su cocina, el cocinero debe tener en cuenta lo que está disponible para cocinar y formar un equilibrio de micronutrientes, carbohidratos, proteínas y grasas. Estos son básicos para lo que los humanos necesitan diariamente para una buena salud, con equilibrio y la porción correcta. Además, el cocinero hace bien en preparar la comida para que la comida sea segura para comer. Esta es la razón por la que la cocina comenzó en primer lugar. Que anhelemos una comida bien cocinada no es una sorpresa, es solo que a menudo no sabemos cómo imaginar nuestro propio menú cuando hay demasiadas opciones. Cómo equilibrar el sabor y la nutrición corresponde con un régimen de ejercicio regular que lo mantiene en forma y listo todos los días.

Esto puede parecer algo básico y lo es, pero equilibrar nuestras vidas requiere paciencia con las cosas que no hacemos bien y entusiasmo por las cosas que hemos dominado. Cada domingo recibimos la gracia del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo para que podamos convertirnos en lo que recibimos y aprender a amar como Cristo ama, perdonar como Cristo perdona y sanar como Cristo sana. Estas acciones fluyen de las acciones muy familiares que se prestan a un estilo de vida saludable, por lo que, naturalmente, las buenas noticias son lo que recibimos y proclamamos en un equilibrio saludable de oración y servicio.

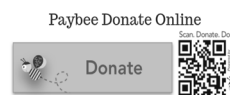

OUR STRATEGIC GOAL

As a Church, we now move into Ordinary Time. "Ordinary" comes from the Latin root for "order," which is why we line the Sundays up on the calendar and count them—with "ordinal" numbers—one by one. The orderly way we proceed through the liturgical year reminds us that our faith offers a strategic goal for our lives: eternal happiness with God, who is love. Today's readings share stories of believers who order their daily activities toward the goal of sharing God's love. Isaiah embraces his role as God's servant and works to bring glory not only to Israel, but to the entire world. In a similar way, Saint Paul identifies himself as Christ's witness in the world and reminds the Corinthians of their life goal: "to be holy." 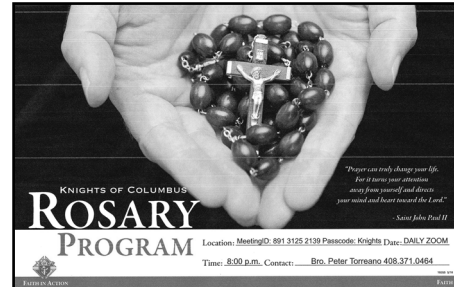
