Listening To Each Other

Growing up in a Catholic household is a uniquely universal experience of family unity that distinguishes itself by a long-standing tradition of love and respect among its members. At the center of this experience, each member recognizes and honors God's presence. Families that seek God's presence form their conscience around Church teaching and attend as well to the Hebrew and Christian scriptures. Moreover, the individual and communal prayer within a household confirms the spiritual life of sharing equal worth. In sum such has been described as the domestic Church and the same leads to wider communal expressions of faith at the parish or neighborhood Church.

These experiences are deep seated for those families that strive to live them. Even so, such an idyllic approach to family faces the pressures and challenges of worldviews different from those that Catholics espouse. From time to time, all of us do well to evaluate our current condition and learn how to improve upon it. There are elements in our culture that undermine traditional approaches with a proven record to keep us mindful of one another. It is nevertheless crucial to gain insight on how we can maintain civil life and social cohesion. (Continued on page 5...)

De vez en cuando, todos hacemos bien en evaluar nuestra condición actual y aprender cómo mejorarla. Hay elementos en nuestra cultura que socavan los enfoques tradicionales que nos ayudan a mantenernos conscientes unos de otros. 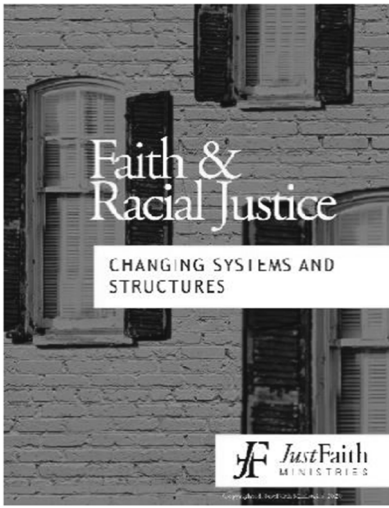

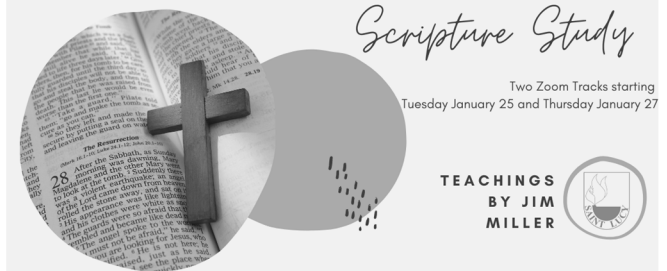

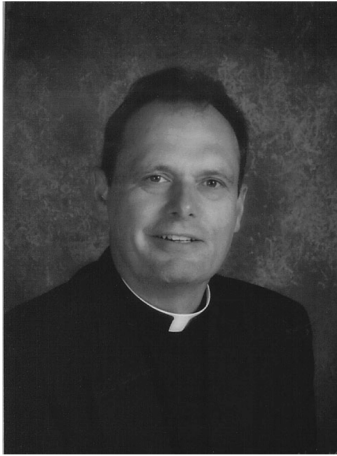

Even as many Catholics are aware, Pope Francis has called a synod on synodality. In response to the call of Pope Francis for all Catholics to be part of the Universal Synod, our Diocese has put together a training module that would allow us to collaborate with Catholic communities (groups, parishes, movements, schools, etc.) and reach out to include non-practicing Catholics to engage in "Listening Sessions."

The objective of the "Listening Session" is to align with the vision of Pope Francis by creating an atmosphere for all people within our Diocesan boundaries to journey together to encounter and listen to the Holy Spirit and one another. Together we can discern the direction the Lord wants for his People.

For that reason, I ask for your help to play an active role as "Facilitators" and "Notetakers" for the "Listening Session." The training sessions will be held online on the following date and times:



- Saturday, January 29, 2022 from 10:00 AM – 11:30 AM
- Saturday, January 29, 2022 from 1:00 PM – 2:30 PM

After attending the training, these new facilitators and note takers will have the tools to lead the listening sessions and they will also be able to assist other volunteers in the facilitation of future sessions. The diocese will provide volunteers with information so they can register their names and emails for the training event. If you would like to volunteer, please contact me or any member of the staff and we will arrange for you to attend the training session.

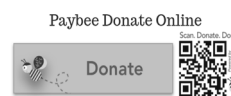

Reflection / Reflexión

REVELATION OF GOD'S PRESENCE

Today's first reading from Isaiah arises out of the ordeal of the people of Jerusalem and Judea as they anticipate the end of seventy years of exile in Babylon. Their sufferings and their oppression will end, and they are promised joy like that of a great wedding upon returning to their homeland. Although this passage is probably set in the early sixth century B.C., it is free of historical particulars. Accordingly, the Church has understood its imagery universally, as it proclaims God's promise of healing, hope, and happiness for all peoples, in this world and in the next. When read against this background, the story of Jesus' turning water into wine at the wedding at Cana becomes a revelation of God's presence in the person of Jesus, making these promises real for us in the here and now, in the transformation of our own lives. REVELACIÓN DE LA PRESENCIA DE DIOS

La primera lectura de hoy de Isaías surge del sufrimiento del pueblo de Jerusalén y de Judea cuando ellos anticiparon el final de los setenta años de exilio en Babilonia. Sus sufrimientos y su opresión terminarán, y se les promete una alegría como la de una boda espléndida al regresar a su patria. Aunque es probable que este pasaje sucedió a principios del siglo VI AC, carece de los detalles históricos. En este sentido, la Iglesia ha entendido sus metáforas de forma universal, ya que proclama la promesa de Dios de curación, esperanza y felicidad para todos los pueblos, en este mundo y en el otro. Cuando se lee este contexto, la historia de Jesús convirtiendo el agua en vino en las bodas de Canaán se convierte en una revelación de la presencia de Dios en la persona de Jesús, haciendo que estás promesas sean verdaderas para nosotros aquí y ahora, en la transformación de nuestras propias vidas.
