True Fulfillment

After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:14-15

Jesus begins His public ministry immediately after being tempted by the devil while in the desert for forty days. As He begins His ministry, He declares: "This is the time of fulfillment." First, the beginning of Jesus' public ministry was, historically speaking, the "time of fulfillment," in that the new era of the Gospel and grace had just begun. But the "time of fulfillment" of which Jesus speaks also refers to each and every time that we hear the Gospel and respond. We do this by sincerely repenting of our sins and by becoming a fuller member of God's Kingdom. But ponder for a moment the specific word "fulfillment." What does this mean?

The word "fulfilled" can be contrasted with its opposite "unfulfilled." To be unfulfilled is always undesirable. In this world, many people find themselves unfulfilled and try to fill this void with many things. (Continued on page 4...)



Verdadera Realización

Después de que arrestaron a Juan, Jesús vino a Galilea proclamando el evangelio de Dios: "Este es el tiempo del cumplimiento. El reino de Dios está cerca. Arrepiéntanse y crean en el evangelio". Marcos 1:14-15

Jesús comienza su ministerio público inmediatamente después de ser tentado por el diablo mientras estuvo en el desierto durante cuarenta días. Al comenzar Su ministerio, declara: "Éste es el tiempo del cumplimiento". Primero, el comienzo del ministerio público de Jesús fue, históricamente hablando, el "tiempo de cumplimiento", en el sentido de que la nueva era del Evangelio y la gracia acababa de comenzar. Pero el "tiempo de cumplimiento" del que habla Jesús también se refiere a todas y cada una de las veces que escuchamos el Evangelio y respondemos. Hacemos esto arrepiéndonos sinceramente de nuestros pecados y convirtiéndonos en miembros más plenos del Reino de Dios. Pero reflexione por un momento sobre la palabra específica "cumplimiento". ¿Qué quiere decir esto?

La palabra "cumplido" se puede contrastar con su opuesto "incumplido". Estar insatisfecho siempre es indeseable. En este mundo, muchas personas se sienten insatisfechas y tratan de llenar ese vacío con muchas cosas. (Continúa en la página 4...)

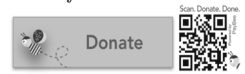

Interestingly, the three temptations that Jesus had just experienced in the desert are among the temptations that so many people give into during their search for fulfillment in life.

First, Jesus was hungry, and the devil tempted Him to turn stones into bread to satiate that hunger. This is a temptation to fleshly fulfillment. Second, the devil tempted Jesus to throw Himself off the pinnacle of the Temple to prove He was the Son of God. This is a temptation to fulfillment by pride—pride to convince another of one’s importance and identity. Third, the devil showed Jesus all the nations of the world and promised them to our Lord if Jesus worshiped him. This is a temptation to fulfillment by obtaining earthly wealth and power. Of course, Jesus rejected all three temptations as a way of showing that none of these truly fulfill us. And He did this just prior to the beginning of His public ministry so as to then go forth preaching the true message of fulfillment. “This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.” True fulfillment is only found in the Gospel, the message of Truth that Jesus shared during His three years of public ministry and then brought to completion by His sacrificial death and resurrection. Only those who heed His words and open themselves to the grace poured forth from the Cross are able to find the fulfillment that they seek.

Reflect, today, upon your own interior desire for fulfillment in life. How do you try to satiate this desire? Do you allow the evil one to trick you into thinking that fleshly desires, pride or wealth are the answer? Reject those temptations with our Lord and then immerse yourself in His Gospel message, which is the only source of fulfillment in life. - mycatholiclife.com

Curiosamente, las tres tentaciones que Jesús acababa de experimentar en el desierto se encuentran entre las tentaciones a las que tantas personas ceden durante su búsqueda de plenitud en la vida.

Primero, Jesús tenía hambre y el diablo lo tentó a convertir las piedras en pan para saciar esa hambre. Ésta es una tentación a la realización carnal. En segundo lugar, el diablo tentó a Jesús a arrojarlo desde el pínaculo del templo para demostrar que era el Hijo de Dios. Ésta es una tentación que se satisface mediante el orgullo: orgullo por convencer a otro de la propia importancia e identidad. En tercer lugar, el diablo le mostró a Jesús todas las naciones del mundo y se las prometió a nuestro Señor si Jesús lo adoraba. Ésta es una tentación de realización mediante la obtención de riqueza y poder terrenales. Por supuesto, Jesús rechazó las tres tentaciones como una manera de mostrar que ninguna de ellas realmente nos llena. Y Él hizo esto justo antes del comienzo de Su ministerio público para luego salir a predicar el verdadero mensaje de cumplimiento. “Éste es el momento del cumplimiento. El reino de Dios está cerca. Arrepiéntanse y crean en el evangelio”.

El verdadero cumplimiento sólo se encuentra en el Evangelio, el mensaje de Verdad que Jesús compartió durante Sus tres años de ministerio público y luego completó con Su muerte sacrificial y resurrección. Sólo aquellos que prestan atención a sus palabras y se abren a la gracia derramada desde la Cruz pueden encontrar la realización que buscan.

Reflexiona hoy sobre tu propio deseo interior de realización en la vida. ¿Cómo intentas saciar este deseo? ¿Permites que el maligno te engañe haciéndote pensar que los deseos carnales, el orgullo o la riqueza son la respuesta? Rechaza esas tentaciones con nuestro Señor y luego sumérgete en Su mensaje evangélico, que es la única fuente de plenitud en la vida. - mycatholiclife.com

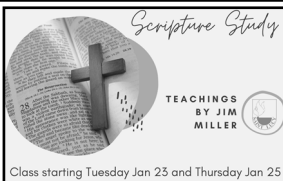

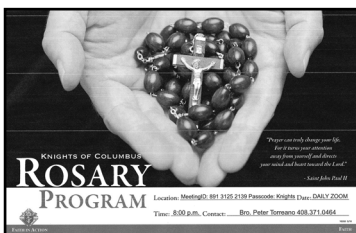
