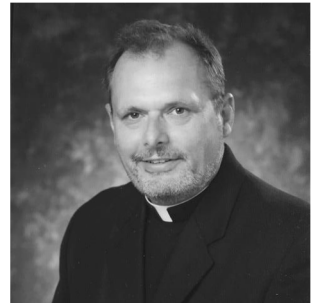

In life, many people hope for an ordered world that is simple to understand and remains as consistent as possible. Extraordinary events arise that lead to changes outside of our control making our current conditions unsustainable. For good or for ill, change is the one constant on which we can rely. As we begin this first part of ordinary time in the new liturgical year, you will notice green more than any other color as an indication of the season we presently celebrate. This brief period of six weeks will give way to the season of Lent beginning on Feb. 22 with Ash Wednesday.

The letter is not very long, and it's best to read it in sections each day. If you decide to read it, you will find some of the most familiar quotes of the Christian texts. The passages we hear on Sunday are very brief, so we won't have the chance to hear most of what Paul has to say in this letter. Now is a good time to read the entire letter as we listen to the second reading the succeeding Sundays before Lent.

Some may ask why we still have this letter or why it was preserved in the first place. It's part of Paul's ministry to write about his experience of forming the various Christian communities in the early Church. Since we have a written record, it's easy to recognize some of Paul's concerns that still plague us today. So, while some of these concerns remain unresolved matters, Paul writes to correct misconceptions about what it means to be a disciple of Christ and the power of his cross and resurrection. This letter can help us to find simple ways of being consistent about how we practice our faith.

It's important to note that some of his ideas have less significance today. His convictions regarding the Parousia or when Jesus would return probably won't resonate with us since so many generations have passed and predictions about the end of the world proved false. Still, his understanding of Church as one body in Christ remains a challenge for all Christians. How we regard one another and the gifts we bring to bear for the good of the community is a critical factor in forming Christian lives today.

This simple letter offers a consistent view to Christian living and how to be spirited in a constantly changing world. You'll benefit from reading it.

La carta no es muy larga, y es mejor leerla en secciones cada día. Si decide leerla, encontrará algunas de las citas más conocidas de los textos cristianos. Los pasajes que escuchamos los domingos son muy breves, por lo que no tendremos la oportunidad de escuchar la mayor parte de lo que Pablo tiene que decir en esta carta. Ahora es un buen momento para leer la carta completa mientras escuchamos la segunda lectura los domingos siguientes antes de la Cuaresma.

Algunos pueden preguntarse por qué todavía tenemos esta carta o por qué se conservó en primer lugar. Es parte del ministerio de Pablo escribir sobre su experiencia de formar las diversas comunidades cristianas en la Iglesia primitiva. Ya que tenemos un registro escrito, es fácil reconocer algunas de las preocupaciones de Pablo que todavía nos atormentan hoy. Entonces, aunque algunas de estas preocupaciones siguen siendo asuntos sin resolver, Pablo escribe para corregir los conceptos erróneos sobre lo que significa ser un discípulo de Cristo y el poder de su cruz y resurrección. Esta carta puede ayudarnos a encontrar formas sencillas de ser coherentes en la forma en que practicamos nuestra fe.

Es importante notar que algunas de sus ideas tienen menos significado hoy. Sus convicciones con respecto a la Parousia o cuándo regresara Jesús probablemente no resuenan con nosotros ya que han pasado tantas generaciones y las predicciones sobre el fin del mundo resultaron ser falsas. Aún así, su comprensión de la Iglesia como un cuerpo en Cristo sigue siendo un desafío para todos los cristianos. La forma en que nos comportamos unos con otros y los dones que aportamos para el bien de la comunidad es un factor crítico en la formación de vidas cristianas hoy.

Esta sencilla carta ofrece una visión coherente de la vida cristiana y de cómo tener ánimo en un mundo en constante cambio. Sugiero que la lea.

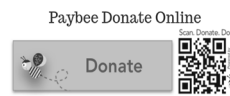

GOD'S LOVING CARE

Two readings today refer to the northeast region of ancient Israel: "the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali." Upon hearing these names, some of us might consult maps and determine exactly where these regions lie. Others might let the unfamiliar names drift by unnoticed. If no maps are handy—but we don't want to ignore the references completely—consider this: we might not know the latitude and longitude of Zebulun and Naphtali, but God does. We praise God for watching over every inch of land and sea, caring perfectly for each creature on the planet. While Isaiah celebrates the depth of God's care with "abundant joy and great rejoicing," Saint Paul begs us to remember how the Lord shows this loving care: through the cross. In today's Gospel, Jesus calls Peter, James, and John to follow him. We follow too, confident that God accompanies us, wherever we are. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

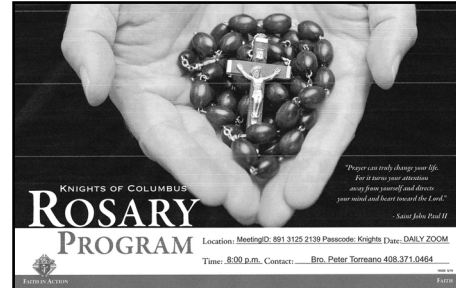

EL CUIDADO AMOROSO DE DIOS

Dos lecturas de hoy se refieren a la región noreste del antiguo Israel: "la tierra de Zabulón y la tierra de Neftalí". Al escuchar estos nombres, algunos de nosotros podríamos consultar mapas y determinar exactamente dónde se encuentran estas regiones. Otros pueden dejar que los nombres desconocidos pasen desapercibidos. Si no tenemos mapas a mano, pero no queremos ignorar las referencias por completo, consideremos esto: puede que no conozcamos la latitud y la longitud de Zabulón y Neftalí, pero Dios sí. Alabamos a Dios por vigilar cada centímetro de tierra y mar, cuidando perfectamente de cada criatura del planeta. Aunque Isaías celebra la profundidad del cuidado de Dios con "abundante alegría y gran regocijo", san Pablo nos ruega que recordemos cómo muestra el Señor este cuidado amoroso: a través de la cruz. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús llama a Pedro, Santiago y Juan para que le sigan. Nosotros también le seguimos, seguros de que Dios nos acompaña, estemos donde estemos salvación. Copyright © J. S. 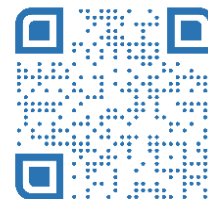

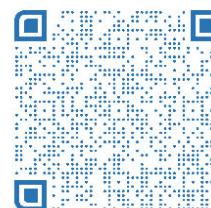
