Enthralled by Jesus

When it was evening, after sunset, they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons. The whole town was gathered at the door. He cured many who were sick with various diseases, and he drove out many demons, not permitting them to speak because they knew him. Mark 1:32-34

Jesus was in the home of Simon Peter whose mother-in-law He had just cured. "The whole town gathered at the door" when evening came. This was Jesus' first time being in Capernaum after beginning His public ministry, and already people were flocking to Him in droves. The next morning, Jesus got up before dawn and went away alone to pray. Soon, some of the disciples found Him and told Him that, once again, the whole town was looking for Him.

The excitement was great. So many were amazed. And their amazement at Jesus was not simply a form of curiosity. It was an amazement fueled by faith, which is why Jesus was able to perform so many miracles there. The people quickly realized that Jesus was the One of Whom the prophets of old had spoken. Cautivado por Jesús

Al atardecer, después del atardecer, le llevaron a todos los que estaban enfermos o endemoniados. Todo el pueblo estaba reunido a la puerta. Curó a muchos que padecían diversas enfermedades y expulsó a muchos demonios, sin permitirles hablar, porque lo conocían. Marcos 1:32-34

Jesús estaba en casa de Simón Pedro, cuya suegra acababa de curar. "Todo el pueblo se reunió a la puerta" cuando llegó la noche. Esta fue la primera vez que Jesús estuvo en Capernaum después de comenzar Su ministerio público, y la gente ya acudía en masa a Él. A la mañana siguiente, Jesús se levantó antes del amanecer y se fue solo a orar. Pronto, algunos de los discípulos lo encontraron y le dijeron que, una vez más, todo el pueblo lo estaba buscando.

La emoción fue grande. Muchos quedaron asombrados. Y su asombro ante Jesús no fue simplemente una forma de curiosidad. Fue un asombro alimentado por la fe, por eso Jesús pudo realizar allí tantos milagros. La gente rápidamente se dio cuenta de que Jesús era Aquel de quien habían hablado los profetas de la antigüedad. 

This is a good image for us to ponder. As you think of the crowds and their unwavering desire to be near our Lord, consider your own desires pertaining to God. Do you regularly find yourself consumed with a desire to find our Lord, to be with Him, to listen to Him and to receive His grace and mercy? Or are you tempted to see Jesus and the practice of your faith as boring and uninteresting? One of the unfortunate effects of modern technology is that we easily become fascinated by and intrigued with many superficial things. Perhaps it's the latest short video on a mobile app, or the latest episode of a favorite television series, or a new post by a friend on social media. There are many things today that compete for our attention, intrigue us and even amaze us. Is Jesus one of those things in your life?

In our modern world of constant stimulation and entertainment, we need to understand the difference between being amazed at the latest pop trend and being amazed by the grace and divine actions of our Lord. When we come face-to-face with the power of God in our lives, we will be amazed in a way that fulfills and satisfies us on the deepest level. It will be a spiritual amazement, which is a gift of the Holy Spirit. And the satisfaction we receive from this form of amazement is transforming, deep and sustaining. But when we turn to lesser and more sensory "amazements" common within our world today, we will find that they last only for a moment, and we are quickly left dry and wanting for more.

Reflect, today, upon the people in today's Gospel who were so enthralled by Jesus that they continually sought Him out. Consider their excitement, their hope and their genuine joy at their discovery of the Messiah. As you think about them, consider whether you share in their excitement about Jesus. If that excitement is lacking, recommit yourself to seeking out our Lord. And where you see that excitement present, rejoice and give glory to God.- mycatholiclife.com

Mientras piensas en las multitudes y su inquebrantable deseo de estar cerca de nuestro Señor, considera tus propios deseos relacionados con Dios. ¿Te encuentras regularmente consumido por el deseo de encontrar a nuestro Señor, estar con Él, escucharlo y recibir Su gracia y misericordia? ¿O estás tentado a ver a Jesús y la práctica de tu fe como algo aburrido y poco interesante? Uno de los efectos desafortunados de la tecnología moderna es que fácilmente nos fascinamos e intrigamos con muchas cosas superficiales. Quizás sea el último video corto de una aplicación móvil, el último episodio de una serie de televisión favorita o una nueva publicación de un amigo en las redes sociales. Hay muchas cosas hoy que compiten por nuestra atención, nos intrigan e incluso nos asombran. ¿Es Jesús una de esas cosas en tu vida?

En nuestro mundo moderno de constante estimulación y entretenimiento, debemos comprender la diferencia entre sorprendernos con la última tendencia pop y sorprendernos por la gracia y las acciones divinas de nuestro Señor. Cuando nos enfrentemos cara a cara con el poder de Dios en nuestras vidas, nos sorprenderemos de una manera que nos llena y satisface en el nivel más profundo. Será un asombro espiritual, que es don del Espíritu Santo. Y la satisfacción que recibimos de esta forma de asombro es transformadora, profunda y sustentadora. Pero cuando recurrimos a "asombros" sensoriales menores y más comunes en nuestro mundo actual, descubriremos que duran sólo un momento, y rápidamente nos quedamos secos y con ganas de más.

Reflexione hoy sobre las personas del Evangelio de hoy que estaban tan cautivadas por Jesús que lo buscaban continuamente. Considere su entusiasmo, su esperanza y su alegría genuina por el descubrimiento del Mesías. Al pensar en ellos, considere si comparte su entusiasmo por Jesús.
