The Problem of Suffering

Most everyone will suffer in life regardless of how well anyone does to keep it at bay. Most do what is necessary to avoid suffering but will still find little choice when faced with it. The experience of suffering is a matter of degree. Each of us has suffered in one form or another or has been witnesses to how others have suffered. You need only watch or read the news of those who endure all forms of turmoil. Each of us has stories that normally include both the joy and sorrow of life. Some tell the story of suffering as an experience of conversion that changed their life and put them on the path to redemption, while others describe mere glimpses of relieve from an enduring physical, emotional, mental, spiritual or environmental affliction for a short time.

Cada uno de nosotros ha sufrido de una forma u otra o ha sido testigo de cómo han sufrido otros. Solo necesita ver o leer las noticias de aquellos que soportan todas las formas de disturbio. Cada uno de nosotros tiene historias que normalmente incluyen tanto la alegría como la tristeza de la vida. Algunos cuentan la historia del sufrimiento como una experiencia de conversión que cambió su vida y los puso en el camino de la redención, mientras que otros describen meros destellos de alivio de una aflicción física, emocional, mental, espiritual o ambiental duradera por un corto tiempo.

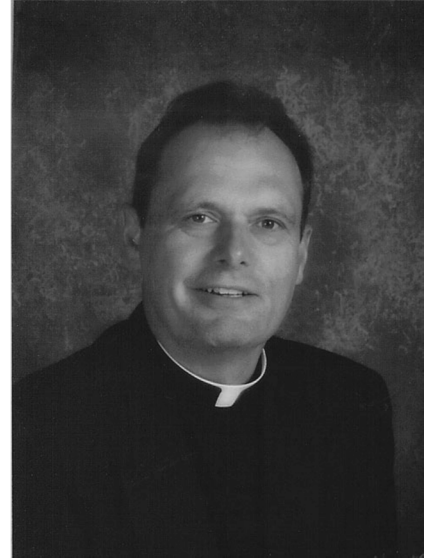

When I was a kid, on Saturday mornings we'd watch cartoons sometimes until lunchtime. One of the many cartoons of that time was Super Chicken. I remember the theme song, and one of the most humorous parts described Super Chicken's sidekick Fred that explained the dangers they faced. "Fred, if you're afraid you'll have to overlook it, you knew the job was dangerous when you took it." This snippet summarizes an approach to suffering; namely, if there is any good reason to endure suffering, may it be transformative.

I have read a spiritual approach to suffering where the author writes, you are going to suffer anyway, might as well suffer for what is just. Not everyone agrees with this approach, but it is a shift that allows us to make some sense of suffering. This approach is transformational. By taking the energy generated from suffering and enduring it patiently, we can transform ourselves and avoid causing others to suffer. If our suffering is to have any meaningful purpose, then we do well to consider how we can be transformative rather than being afflicted or afflicting others with the senseless experiences that suffering generates.

The early Christian community was not encouraged by the suffering and death of Jesus, but they understood it in the context of his resurrection. The story of how Jesus goes about salvation is not tied to the avoidance of suffering but begins to answer why anyone must suffer at all. Some Catholics imagine that taking up the cross means that we must stoically accept the difficulties of life. Instead, we do well to encourage the members of the church to take up one's cross as a path to salvation. We do well to consider the paschal mystery as means to an active participation in redemption and to be life-giving for the sake of the gospel.

Cuando era niño, los sábados por la mañana veíamos caricaturas en la televisión a veces hasta la hora del almuerzo. Uno de las muchas caricaturas de esa época era Super Chicken. Recuerdo la canción del tema principal, y una de las partes más divertidas era cuando el compañero de Super Chicken, Fred, explicaba los peligros a los que se enfrentaban. "Fred, tienes miedo de tener que pasarlo cuando sabes que el trabajo era peligroso cuando lo aceptaste." Este fragmento resume una aproximación al sufrimiento; es decir, si hay alguna buena razón para soportar el sufrimiento, es que sea transformador.

He leído un enfoque espiritual del sufrimiento donde el autor escribe, vas a sufrir de todos modos, mas vale que también sufras por lo que es justo. No todos están de acuerdo con este enfoque, pero es un cambio que nos permite darle algún sentido al sufrimiento. Este enfoque es transformacional. Tomando la energía generada por el sufrimiento y soportándola con paciencia, podemos transformarnos y evitar causar sufrimiento a otros. Si nuestro sufrimiento debe tener algún propósito significativo, entonces hacemos bien en considerar cómo podemos ser transformadores en lugar de ser afligidos o afligir a otros con las experiencias sin sentido que genera el sufrimiento.

La comunidad cristiana primitiva no se sintió alentado por el sufrimiento y la muerte de Jesús, pero lo entendieron en el contexto de su resurrección. La historia de cómo Jesús emprende la salvación no está ligada a evitar el sufrimiento, sino que comienza a responder por qué alguien debe sufrir en absoluto. Algunos católicos imaginan que tomar la cruz significa que debemos aceptar estoicamente las dificultades de la vida. En cambio, hacemos bien en animar a los miembros de la iglesia a tomar su propia cruz como camino a la salvación. Hacemos bien en considerar el misterio pascual como medio para una participación activa en la redención y para ser dador de vida por causa del evangelio.

Reflection / Reflexión

THEOPHANIES

Today's readings recount three theophanies, or particular manifestations of God's presence. The prophet Isaiah is caught up in a dramatic scene of heavenly worship, with a royal throne, burning embers, and seraphim singing, "Holy, holy, holy." Isaiah is overwhelmed. In the responsorial psalm, the assembly adds its own worship to that of the seraphim: "In the sight of the angels, I will sing your praises, Lord" (Psalm 138:1).

Paul reminds the Corinthians of his own experience of a post-Resurrection appearance of the Lord, making him an apostle, but one "born abnormally" (1 Corinthians 15:8), since he had no acquaintance with the earthly Jesus. The first of those who did know the earthly Jesus were surprised by fishing advice from the teacher who had commandeered Simon's boat, resulting in an extraordinary catch. 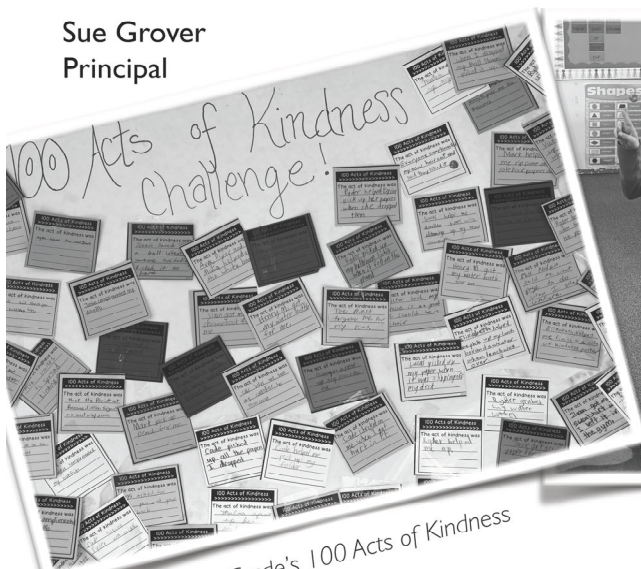
