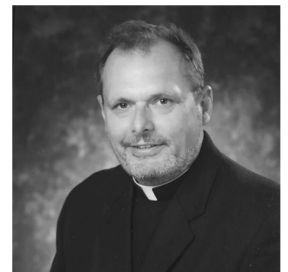

Winter's Rhythm

Here we are during the middle of winter, and it's easy to understand why so many call this season hard to endure. We may not have the freezing temperatures and snow like the folks back east or those living in mountainous regions, but when it rains it pours in California. Sometimes floods or landslides follow, as evidenced in the events that have unfolded throughout California. While there was a decent amount of rainfall in recent storms, we welcome the rain in hopes that our drought will end soon.



If you are in touch with the natural rhythms of this season, then you know that winter can be a period of introspection and careful evaluation of how to make the best of our time. When the weather tends to be inclement, we spend more of our time indoors. It does not keep us from our work, though it may be more difficult to do in winter what you can more easily do in spring or summer months. Aquí estamos en pleno invierno, y es fácil entender por qué tantos dicen que esta estación es difícil de soportar. As a species, we have not evolved so much. Our environment is always changing and whether we can perceive it or not we are changing with it. Now that the winter solstice is past, you can observe the sun rise a little earlier every day. The rhythm is slower than the planned rhythms of our scheduled lives, and every now and then we need to take the time to refresh by following a more thoughtful approach to how we are living. That's how improvement works—it's gradual and cumulative.

In the natural rhythm of life, there is the sense that God is working in the same deliberate way with us. If you are attentive, then you will slow down enough to realize how you can be transformed into the image of God rather than trying to make God into your own image.

Looking inside is especially difficult when the interior life is in disarray. It didn't get that way over night, and changing what we can is gradual and cumulative. As we move away from the shortest period of daylight in the northern hemisphere, as we anticipate the season of Lent and draw nearer to the vernal equinox, let us take time for regular prayer and reflection even as winter begins to wane. Doing so will help us chart a course for the days, weeks, and months ahead. We can begin to organize whatever is in disarray interiorly and rediscover the richness of timelessness. Following the winter's pace keeps us living in the moment.

Como especie humana, no hemos evolucionado tanto. Nuestro entorno siempre está cambiando y, ya sea que podamos percibirlo o no, estamos cambiando con él. Ahora que ha pasado el solsticio de invierno, puedes observar la salida del sol un poco más temprano todos los días. El ritmo es más lento que los ritmos de nuestras vidas programadas, y de vez en cuando necesitamos tomarnos el tiempo para refrescarnos siguiendo un enfoque más reflexivo de cómo estamos viviendo. Así es como funciona la mejora: es gradual y acumulativa.

En el ritmo natural de la vida, existe la sensación de que Dios está obrando de la misma manera deliberada con nosotros. Si está atento, disminuirá la velocidad lo suficiente como para darse cuenta de cómo puede ser transformado a la imagen de Dios en lugar de tratar de hacer de Dios su propia imagen.

Mirar hacia adentro es especialmente difícil cuando la vida interior está desordenada. No fue así de la noche a la mañana, y cambiar lo que podemos es gradual y acumulativo. Mientras nos alejamos del período más corto de luz del día en el hemisferio norte, anticipamos la temporada de Cuaresma y nos acercamos al equinoccio vernal, tomemos tiempo para la oración y la reflexión regular incluso cuando el invierno comienza a decaer. Si lo hace, nos ayudará a trazar un curso para los días, semanas y meses venideros. Podemos comenzar a organizar interiormente lo que está en desorden y redescubrir la riqueza de la atemporalidad. Seguir el ritmo del invierno nos mantiene viviendo el momento.

THE GLORY OF THE DIVINE WAY

Today's readings draw us into ageless, vibrant depths. Followers of God's law, we belong to ancient traditions. Children of God, we marvel at the freshness of creation. The Old Testament readings, from Sirach and the Psalms, celebrate the rich blessings we receive when we observe God's commands—not because we are slaves to the law, but because the law gives life in abundance. Saint Paul's Letter to the Corinthians confirms the glory of divine law, but warns that God's ways tend to be unpopular and misunderstood in this world. Paul speaks of the ancient wisdom of God, which is mysteriously both "hidden" and "revealed." God does not have secret codes that we earthly mortals cannot understand; in love, God reveals the glory of the divine way in Jesus. Saint Matthew's Gospel emphasizes the importance of living in God's law, enlivened by a deep and personal relationship with Jesus. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

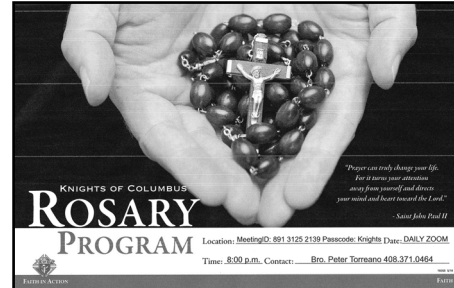


