Prophetic Ministry

Anyone who has attended catechism has at least been introduced to the Hebrew prophets like Moses, Isaiah, or Ezequiel.

If you've completed further studies in scripture, then you may understand the Hebrew Prophets as those who would speak on God's behalf. In much of the prophetic literature, many the writings include the phrase, "For thus says the Lord God." Primarily, they prophesied against corruption and injustice and were fierce advocates for the poor, the stranger, orphans, and widows. Rebels with obstinate hearts or those inclined to break the covenant despised the prophet in their midst. While openly derided and oppressed, the Hebrew prophets did not shrink from their duty to serve as God commanded.

It seems very few would agree willingly to answer God's call to serve as a prophet, even though each of us was baptized in the royal priesthood and prophetic ministry of Jesus. The prophet cannot keep from speaking what is true and remains joyful in faithful service to God.

Ministerio Profético

Cualquiera que haya asistido al catecismo ha sido presentado a los profetas hebreos como Moisés, Isaías o Ezequiel. Si completó más estudios de las Escrituras, entonces conoce a los profetas hebreos como aquellos que hablan en nombre de Dios. En gran parte de la literatura profética, muchos escritos incluyen la frase: "Porque así dice el Señor Dios". Principalmente, profetizaron contra la corrupción y la injusticia y fueron feroces defensores de los pobres, los extranjeros, los huérfanos y las viudas. Los rebeldes de corazón obstinado o aquellos inclinados a quebrantar el pacto despreciaron al profeta entre ellos. Aunque abiertamente ridiculizados y oprimidos, los profetas hebreos no rehuyeron su deber de servir como Dios les ordenó.

Parece que muy pocos aceptarían voluntariamente responder al llamado de Dios para servir como profeta, aunque cada uno de nosotros haya sido bautizado en el sacerdocio real y el ministerio profético de Jesús. El profeta no puede dejar de hablar la verdad y permanece gozoso en el servicio fiel a Dios.

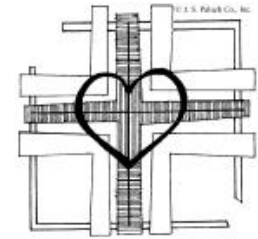

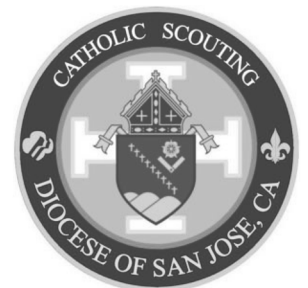

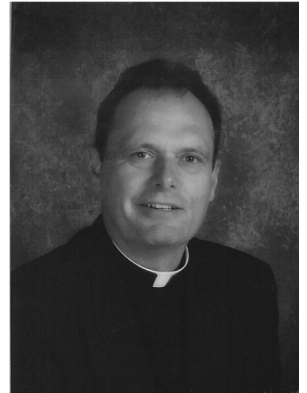

Faithfulness and fortitude are defining characteristics of prophetic ministry. Even so, while it's likely there are few today who would willingly answer to this vocation, I am certain there are those who have this capacity.

How do we make each person in our families feel as though they belong? When there are sibling rivalries, there are going to be disagreements, and parents have the unenviable task of telling their child from time to time, "you're probably not going to like this, but..." you fill in the blank. Believe me, when my parents started the conversation like that, I knew I was going to be disappointed and likely unhappy for a while.

Being a part of community means that conflict is inevitable, and the best way to overcome conflict is to have it with people you trust that will work with you towards managing it. In many respects, Jesus was prophetic in the way that he confronted the injustices visited upon the poor, the widow, and the stranger of his time, but he also healed those in need, forgave sins, and taught others how to love God and their neighbor as themselves.

Among human families, groups, communities, regions, states, and nations, conflict is part of what humans cannot avoid. It's not all bad as conflict can be a catalyst for a clear vision about the things that make sense, how things are meant to come together, and what will result in a deeper sense of trust and fidelity. We can't dwell on points over which we disagree for too long or else the disagreement will become the focus. Rather, may we find wisdom in the Prophetic literature of scripture and learn to speak what is true.

La fidelidad y la fortaleza son características definitorias del ministerio profético. Aun así, aunque es probable que hoy en día haya pocos que estén dispuestos a responder a esta vocación, estoy seguro de que hay quienes tienen esta capacidad.

¿Cómo hacemos que cada persona de nuestra familia se sienta como si pertenece? Cuando hay rivalidades entre hermanos, van a haber desacuerdos, y los padres tienen la poco envidiable tarea de decirle a su hijo de vez en cuando, "probablemente esto no te va a gustar, pero...", llene el espacio en blanco. Créame, cuando mis padres comenzaron la conversación de esa manera, yo sabía que me sentiría decepcionado y probablemente infeliz por un tiempo.

Ser parte de la comunidad significa que el conflicto es inevitable, y la mejor manera de superarlo es contar con personas de confianza que trabajarán contigo para manejarlo. En muchos aspectos, Jesús fue profético en la forma en que enfrentó las injusticias que sufrían los pobres, las viudas y los extranjeros de su tiempo, pero también sanó a los necesitados, perdonó los pecados y enseñó a otros a amar a Dios y a sus prójimo como a sí mismo.

Entre las familias humanas, los grupos, las comunidades, las regiones, los estados y las naciones, el conflicto es parte de lo que los seres humanos no pueden evitar. No todo es malo, ya que el conflicto puede ser un catalizador para una visión clara sobre las cosas, cómo deben unirse las cosas y qué resultará en un sentido más profundo de confianza y fidelidad. No podemos detenernos demasiado en los puntos en los que no estamos de acuerdo o, de lo contrario, el desacuerdo se convertirá en el centro de atención. Más bien, que encontremos sabiduría en la literatura profética de las Escrituras y aprendamos a decir la verdad.

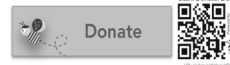

Reflection / Reflexión

THEOPHANIES

Today's readings recount three theophanies, or particular manifestations of God's presence. The prophet Isaiah is caught up in a dramatic scene of heavenly worship, with a royal throne, burning embers, and seraphim singing, "Holy, holy, holy." Isaiah is overwhelmed. In the responsorial psalm, the assembly adds its own worship to that of the seraphim: "In the sight of the angels, I will sing your praises, Lord" (Psalm 138:1).

Paul reminds the Corinthians of his own experience of a post-Resurrection appearance of the Lord, making him an apostle, but one "born abnormally" (1 Corinthians 15:8), since he had no acquaintance with the earthly Jesus. The first of those who did know the earthly Jesus were surprised by fishing advice from the teacher who had commandeered Simon's boat, resulting in an extraordinary catch.
