Living Freedom

The US was forged by an allied effort to overthrow the oppressive rule of the British Crown. Citizens of other nations watched with rapt attention to the great American experiment as we applied modern philosophical ideas to the way the nation governed. It was truly revolutionary insofar as it was a departure from a centralized figure of power wielding by decree whatever was in mind of the ruler. We rely on the current form of governance in the US —a system of checks and balances that demonstrate how well or poorly democracy works. Democracy has flaws like any system or human endeavor, but it's the best way we know to generate a sense of common interests and values so to stand united on principle and fulfill our destiny as a people.

Given our political approach, we are not so inclined, nor do we desire to return to a servile condition in where freedom is based on the definitive decree of a single individual having power over most people. (Continued on page 5...)

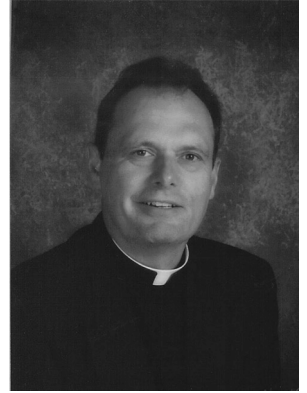

On the other hand, while we might bristle at the idea of being ruled or directed, we do well to acknowledge how the wisdom and direction that one person can bring to the human condition is essential. Consequently, we can anticipate good direction from a leader that can show the way as we progress together—a progression that includes every person's participation. As much as we may wish to assert our right as individuals and claim personal freedom, it's not clear whether that approach leads to true liberation. That process requires us to recognize how all of us are so unlike God. We may be found in the image and likeness of God, but God remains immutable while we are constantly changing. Even so we rely on God's ability to bring all things into being, and we believe that God alone has this power.



Forgoing our personal freedom for a higher calling that liberates and directs us is the kind of freedom that God imbued in each one of us. Knowing that the US Constitution decrees the same certainly gives us an advantage insofar as we can practice the faith of our religion in a way that corresponds to what we value most. Our religion is meant to draw us together and direct our actions towards the good. Even so, the freedom imbued in us by God is not so much by decree or declaration but by our ability to perceive a power we cannot fully possess with which we can participate personally and communally. That is a great responsibility because it recognizes the freedom no one can take away whether threatened by a dictator or rule of law.

Por otro lado, aunque podemos enfurecernos ante la idea de ser gobernados o dirigidos, hacemos bien en reconocer cómo la sabiduría y la dirección que una persona puede aportar a la condición humana son esenciales. En consecuencia, podemos anticipar una buena dirección de un líder que puede mostrar el camino a medida que avanzamos juntos, una progresión que incluye la participación de cada persona. Por mucho que deseemos hacer valer nuestro derecho como individuos y reclamar la libertad personal, no está claro si ese enfoque conduce a la verdadera liberación. Ese proceso requiere que reconozcamos cómo todos nosotros somos tan diferentes a Dios. Puede que seamos hechos a imagen y semejanza de Dios, pero Dios permanece inmutable mientras nosotros cambiamos constantemente. Aun así, confiamos en la capacidad de Dios para traer todas las cosas a la existencia, y creemos que solo Dios tiene este poder.

Renunciar nuestra libertad personal por un llamado superior que nos libere y dirija es el tipo de libertad que Dios infundió en cada uno de nosotros. Saber que la Constitución de los Estados Unidos decreta lo mismo ciertamente nos da una ventaja en que podemos practicar la fe de nuestra religión de una manera que corresponde a lo que más valoramos. Nuestra religión está destinada a unirnos y dirigir nuestras acciones hacia el bien. Aun así, la libertad que Dios nos ha imbuido no es tanto por decreto o declaración sino por nuestra capacidad de percibir un poder que no podemos poseer plenamente y con el cual podemos participar personal y comunitariamente. Esa es una gran responsabilidad porque reconoce la libertad que nadie nos puede quitar, ya sea amenazada por un dictador o por la ley.

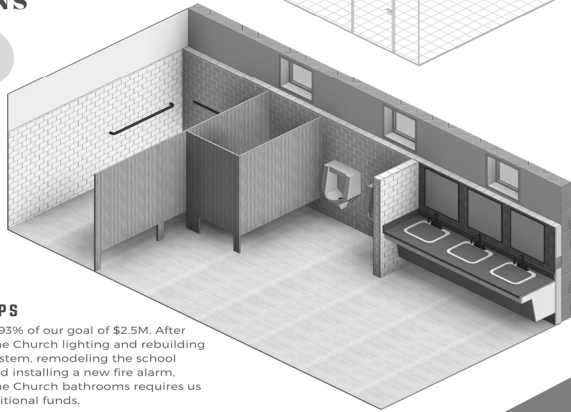

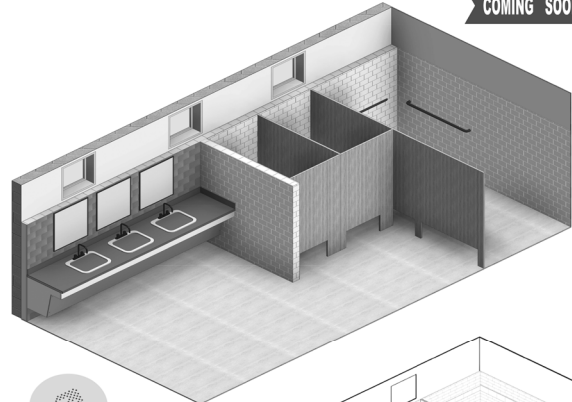

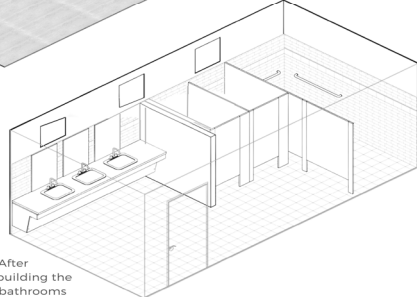

ACTUAL COSTS

-\$1.3M School Bathrooms & Staff Room Upgrades

- Fire Alarm systems were brought up to code for compliance, we were not allowed to grandfather the existing alarm system
- Added utility room to supplement the loss of previous space

-\$768k Church Interior Lighting

- Added expense for comprehensive architectural design
- Required a new extensive lighting analysis to better design placement
- Remediation of church ceiling asbestos
- Light fixtures upgraded for design durability and longevity, expense greater than the original budget.
- Additional charges to cover the cost of ceiling repair, stucco, and painting.

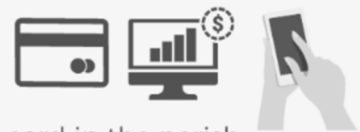

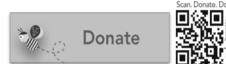
