Triduum

As we gather for this year's Palm Sunday celebration, let us be mindful of our Christian brothers and sisters throughout the world. At the entrance of the Church, you will find blessed palms to mark the beginning of Holy Week. Today's celebration recalls Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, not as warrior king but as the prince of peace. This adulation is short-lived as evidenced by Jesus' arrest and subjection that resulted in a sentence of crucifixion, a form of capital punishment reserved for non-Roman citizens and those regarded as subversive.

To many of the religious leaders in Jerusalem, Jesus was considered a troublemaker. They conspired to find a way of putting him to death and found his message about God's love and forgiveness presented the opportunity to have him arrested and tried. Roman law was quite clear on matters of sedition, and anyone attempting to upset the law and order enforced among the lands Rome conquered was subject to judgment under the law. Triduo

Mientras nos reunimos para la celebración del Domingo de Ramos de este año, recordemos a nuestros hermanos y hermanas cristianos en todo el mundo. A la entrada de la Iglesia encontrarás palmas benditas para marcar el inicio de la Semana Santa. La celebración de hoy recuerda la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén, no como rey guerrero sino como príncipe de paz. Esta adulación es de corta duración, como lo demuestra el arresto y sujeción de Jesús que resultó en una sentencia de crucifixión, una forma de pena capital reservada para los ciudadanos no romanos y aquellos considerados subversivos.

Para muchos de los líderes religiosos de Jerusalén, Jesús era considerado un alborotador. Conspiraron para encontrar una manera de darle muerte y encontraron que su mensaje sobre el amor y el perdón de Dios presentaba la oportunidad de arrestarlo y juzgarlo. La ley romana era bastante clara en materia de sedición, y cualquiera que intentara trastornar la ley y el orden en las tierras conquistadas por Roma estaba sujeto a juicio conforme a la ley. 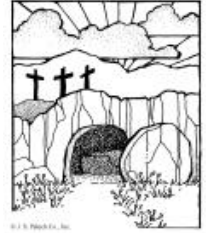

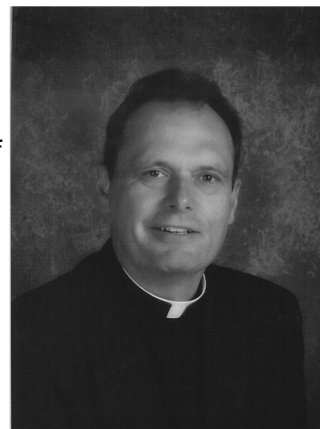

While he proved a very popular preacher, healer, and prophet, Jesus was falsely accused and faced a humiliating death with few that stayed near him until the end.

With the events the Church celebrates this week, we take to heart Jesus' message of God's Kingdom and continually learn how to be closely aligned with Jesus. We may find it troubling to listen and meditate on the passion accounts of Luke this Sunday and John on Good Friday. Even though we already know how these accounts end, we take time to reconsider what happens to Jesus and what effect it has on us. We may wonder why Jesus had to die this way or why his disciples abandoned, denied, and betrayed him. Is it possible for us to be true disciples of Jesus—to love and forgive as Jesus did and teaches us to do?

This Thursday, we celebrate a Mass at 7:30pm that recalls the Passover meal Jesus shares with his disciples. The first reading recalls the first Passover Meal and how God frees the Israelites from slavery. This saving act corresponds to the way Jesus brings the fullness of God's salvation but not in the way any of us could expect. When we put our faith and trust in this message of salvation, our response to God's promise leads us to gratitude and joy because we know we are moving closer to true discipleship.

Good Friday services begin at 12:30 with the Solemn Celebration of the Lord's Passion, followed by the Stations of the Cross at approximately 1:30pm. There is no morning Mass, Confessions, or 5:15 pm Mass on Holy Saturday. The Easter Vigil begins at 8:30. See page 6 of this bulletin for a detailed listing.

Jesús demostró ser un predicador, sanador y profeta muy popular, pero fue acusado falsamente y enfrentó una muerte humillante con pocos que permanecieron cerca de él hasta el final.

Con los eventos que la Iglesia celebra esta semana, tomamos en serio el mensaje de Jesús sobre el Reino de Dios y aprendemos continuamente cómo estar estrechamente alineados con Jesús. Nos molestará escuchar sobre los relatos de la pasión de Lucas este domingo y de Juan el Viernes Santo. Aunque ya sabemos cómo terminan estos relatos, nos tomamos un tiempo para reconsiderar lo que le sucede a Jesús y qué efecto tiene en nosotros. Podemos preguntarnos por qué Jesús tuvo que morir de esta manera o por qué sus discípulos lo abandonaron, lo negaron y lo traicionaron. ¿Es posible que nos volveremos verdaderos discípulos de Jesús— amar y perdonar como Jesús lo hizo y nos enseña como hacer?

Este jueves celebramos una Misa a las 7:30 pm que recuerda la cena de Pascua que Jesús comparte con sus discípulos. La primera lectura recuerda la primera Cena de Pascua y cómo Dios libera a los israelitas de la esclavitud. Este acto salvífico corresponde a la forma en que Jesús trae la plenitud de la salvación de Dios, pero no en la forma en que cualquiera de nosotros podría esperar. Cuando ponemos nuestra fe y confianza en este mensaje de salvación, nuestra respuesta a la promesa de Dios nos lleva a la gratitud y al gozo porque sabemos que nos estamos acercando al verdadero discipulado.

Los servicios del Viernes Santo comienzan a las 6:30 con el Via Crucis seguido a las 7 pm Celebración Solemne de la Pasión del Señor. 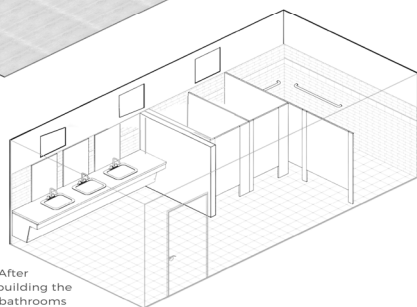


CHURCH ENTRANCE WOMEN'S RESTROOM

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, one of the most significant moments of the Church year. During this week, we journey with Christ from his triumphant entry into Jerusalem to his final meal with his closest friends and ultimately to his death on the cross.



As we walk with Jesus through Holy Week, we call to mind the countless men, women and children who even today carry heavy crosses: crosses of hunger, of homelessness, of a lack of resources or security. In these brothers and sisters we encounter Christ, as he walks that long road to Calvary. In these encounters, it's important not to forget an essential pillar of Lenten spirituality—almsgiving—which allows us to help those who are most in need.

This final week of Lent is also a time to reflect on those words of Saint Paul to the Philippians. Jesus emptied himself for us; how might we empty ourselves for others? Our Lenten prayers, fasting and almsgiving have prepared us to wrestle with this question.

We must always remember that Holy Week gives way to Easter—the fast turns into a feast. God wins the day. As we prepare to celebrate Easter with joy, it is our responsibility as members of God's one human family to share that joy with everyone, near and far.

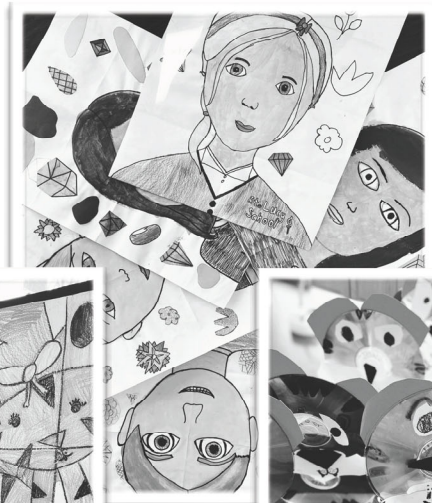
