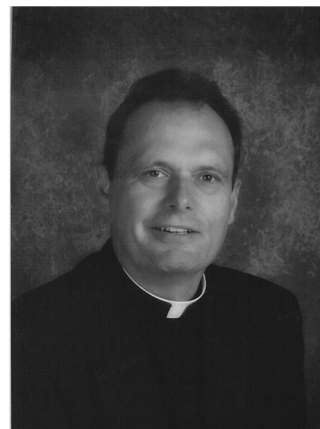

For the Apostles, the event of Jesus' death was a direct experience. The gospel accounts are a written testimony of what they encountered with the risen Christ. In the resurrection, Jesus dies no more and lives forever as the firstborn from the dead. Where he has gone, we hope to follow. Even so, we enjoy Jesus' presence in our lives now in order to form a deeper relationship with him by concord with one another.



We live with the hope and promise of resurrection as an experience grounded in faith. The kingdom of God is among us—living in us—and the resurrection gives us the vision to transcend the brokenness and darkness of this world. Jesus is a light in the darkness for all of humanity. He shows us how we can live with one another and the desire to love as God loves us. With God all things are possible, and God's power is meant to transform our lives. If we keep an open mind to the message of the gospel and live the paschal mystery, God will show us our true self and our place among each other. While everything is changing, God's love for us remains as an eternal offer even in the darkest hour. God does not abandon his son to death and neither will God abandon us.

Today's celebration gives us cause to hope. It is more important than ever, since the experience of resurrection allows us to understand how the darkness and sadness of death give way to the promise of light and new life. Jesus has won the victory for us; he saves us from our sinful inclination, and lifts us up so that we may be known as God's own children. Alleluia, blessed be the name of God, alleluia!

Para los Apóstoles, el acontecimiento de la muerte de Jesús fue una experiencia directa. Los relatos de los evangelios son un testimonio escrito de lo que encontraron con el Cristo resucitado. En la resurrección, Jesús no muere más y vive para siempre como el primogénito de entre los muertos. Donde él ha ido, esperamos seguirlo. Aun así, disfrutamos la presencia de Jesús en nuestras vidas ahora para formar una relación más profunda con él por medio de la concordia con otros.

Vivimos con la esperanza y la promesa de la resurrección como una experiencia basada en la fe. El reino de Dios está entre nosotros, viviendo en nosotros, y la resurrección nos da la visión para trascender el quebrantamiento y la oscuridad de este mundo. Jesús es una luz en la oscuridad para toda la humanidad. Nos muestra cómo podemos vivir unos con otros con el deseo de amar como Dios nos ama. Con Dios todo es posible, y el poder de Dios está destinado a transformar nuestras vidas. Si mantenemos una mente abierta al mensaje del evangelio y vivimos el misterio pascual, Dios nos mostrará nuestro verdadero yo y nuestro lugar entre nosotros. Mientras todo cambia, el amor de Dios por nosotros permanece como una oferta eterna incluso en la hora más oscura. Dios no abandona a su hijo a la muerte y Dios tampoco nos abandonará a nosotros.

La celebración de hoy nos da motivos para la esperanza. Es más importante que nunca, ya que la experiencia de la resurrección nos permite comprender cómo las tinieblas y la tristeza de la muerte dan paso a la promesa de luz y vida nueva. Jesús ha ganado la victoria por nosotros; nos salva de nuestra inclinación para pecar y nos eleva para que seamos conocidos como hijos de Dios. ¡Aleluya, bendito sea el nombre de Dios, aleluya!

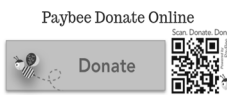

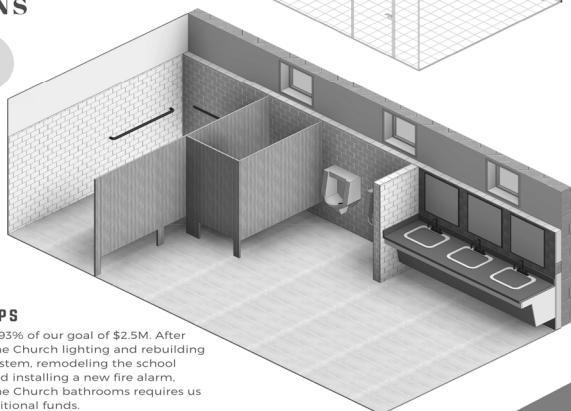

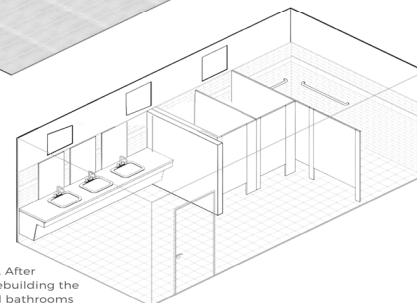

URGENT NEED IN UKRAINE

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) - our second collection next weekend- in recent weeks has increased its presence in Ukraine, Moldova, Romania, and Poland. CRS is supporting Caritas Ukraine by providing shelter, food and livelihood support for those displaced and affected by the war. CRS is also helping Caritas partners in Moldova, Romania, and Poland to prepare for displaced people, mapping out a likely initial response and conducting assessment and planning sessions with its network near Ukraine's borders.

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, one of the most significant moments of the Church year. During this week, we journey with Christ from his triumphant entry into Jerusalem to his final meal with his closest friends and ultimately to his death on the cross.



As we walk with Jesus through Holy Week, we call to mind the countless men, women and children who even today carry heavy crosses: crosses of hunger, of homelessness, of a lack of resources or security. In these brothers and sisters we encounter Christ, as he walks that long road to Calvary. In these encounters, it's important not to forget an essential pillar of Lenten spirituality—almsgiving—which allows us to help those who are most in need.

This final week of Lent is also a time to reflect on those words of Saint Paul to the Philippians. Jesus emptied himself for us; how might we empty ourselves for others? Our Lenten prayers, fasting and almsgiving have prepared us to wrestle with this question.

We must always remember that Holy Week gives way to Easter—the fast turns into a feast. God wins the day. As we prepare to celebrate Easter with joy, it is our responsibility as members of God's one human family to share that joy with everyone, near and far.

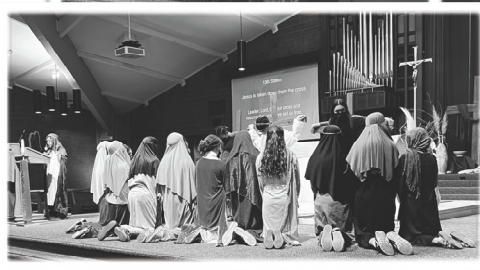

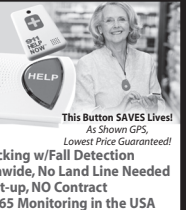
