Notes from the Synodal Process

Though there was a small percentage of parishioners who participated in these sessions, the comments of the participants were what one might expect from people who love the Church and have found a home at this community of St. Lucy. As you might imagine, it feels great to know the support of many who have a stake in the ministry and mission of the Church in Santa Clara County and our fair city of Campbell. Much of what participants expressed in our groups was facilitated by creating the right kind of environment. From the beginning of our conversations, we all agreed to listen and refrain from comments. What we heard in our groups and what the note takers recorded that evening reveals the kind of honesty and enthusiasm that's hard to create in any setting. It was a refreshing surprise to hear some very competent and positive parishioners expressing what they love about our experience as Church and how we can make it better than the way we found it. 1. Church is personally experienced today in
 - Mass, devotions
 - active involvement (RCIA, youth ministry, finance, lector, EM)
 - interaction in broader community, in fellowship with family and friends
 - life with the parish, deepening practice of faith in community
 - being with people in life stages, helping them be who they are called to be in Jesus
2. The following joys are experienced:
 - When everything comes together because we work together on God's work
 - Mass, liturgy and community, gathering together in sacred space, devotions
 - Facilitating enhancement of understanding of self and others
 - Witnessing youth participation, teaching Catechism
 - Living Catholic ethos, understanding our relationship to Jesus and the love he offers in the sacraments and presence of Jesus in our midst
 - Loving in most difficult times
 - Sharing faith
 - Bible Study, a Well-written and well-delivered homily
3. The following difficulties and obstacles have been encountered:
 - Unnecessary consternation in preparation/lack there of liturgy
 - 80 percent of work done by 20 percent of people
 - lack of understanding of Real Presence
 - lack of fellowship opportunities
 - people talking in Church before liturgy begins
 - closed Church building
 - resistance to change, unwillingness to grow and develop, rigid guidelines
 - unwillingness to see differences, troubling lack of empathy for suffering of gay Catholics and family
 - Interest in making money and leaving, leading to disinterest in putting down roots. Community is dying and disintegrating.
 - Ignorant delusion stemming from Modern philosophy that one can separate spirituality from religion.
 - Modern Thought's individualistic mentality is antithetical to community building.

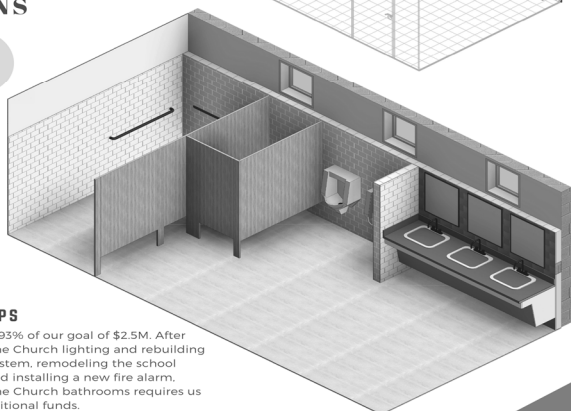

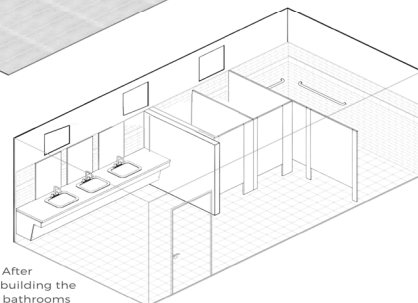
