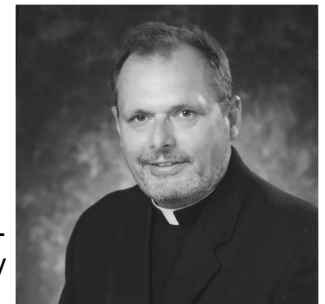

**First Communion**

Adult Catholics can remember their first communion, and some may acknowledge how things have changed since that time. Everyone knows it's a big event because the

entire family attends. In my own experience, we prepared for this sacrament in very much the same way as children do today although in my time many of us had Religious Sisters who were integral to parish life and catechetical instruction. They always encouraged us to be reverent in prayer. Any sort of misbehavior was met with swift, severe reprisal and public embarrassment.



Easter seems the best season to celebrate first communion. At St. Lucy, we celebrate this important milestone with parish families this and next Saturday. Those preparing for first communion learn to practice our faith as we all do by attending Sunday Mass and receive the Eucharist as a source for our life in Christ. (Continued on page 4...)

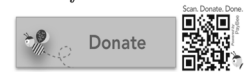

Those who receive on Saturday have also the opportunity to receive Jesus again in the Eucharist on Sunday for their second communion. It's reasonable to conclude that this celebration is the first of many in a lifetime of faith incorporated in the Body of Christ. These are some of the first steps in becoming fully initiated and mature Roman Catholics.

Parents pass the tradition of faith onto their children. Crucial to this transmission of faith from one generation to the next is the Christian Community that remains. People willing to work together in solidarity for a singular cause is essential to the nature of being Church. The Greek word Ekklesia means to be as one called by God. This described the community that gathered to hear God's word and give thanks to God through the Eucharistic meal. Ideally, the word Ekklesia is meant to describe the various members that comprise the local Christian Community who are answering God's call to a vocation in life.

As the children receiving their first communion at St. Lucy walk in processions down the aisle this Saturday and next, we give thanks to God for those who are ready to receive Jesus with open arms. The light these children received when they were baptized still glows with brilliance and gives light their eyes. Many of the children are 7 years or older. They have been preparing this year for this special day and we are happy to support them with our prayers and good wishes. Springtime is a season of renewal. Just so, the Easter Season is an appropriate time to celebrate these sacraments of initiation as a renewal of faith and to revisit our own initiation with those received more fully into the life of the Church. Let these celebrations be for us a time of grace and thanksgiving.

Los que reciben el sábado también tienen la oportunidad de recibir a Jesús nuevamente en la Eucaristía el domingo para su segunda comunión. Es razonable concluir que esta celebración es la primera de muchas en una vida de fe incorporada en el Cuerpo de Cristo. Estos son algunos de los primeros pasos para convertirse en católicos romanos plenamente iniciados y maduros.

Los padres transmiten la tradición de la fe a sus hijos. Crucial para esta transmisión de la fe de una generación a la siguiente es la comunidad cristiana que permanece. Personas dispuestas a trabajar juntas en solidaridad por una causa singular es esencial para ser Iglesia. La palabra griega Ekklesia significa ser como alguien llamado por Dios. Así es la comunidad que se reúne para escuchar la palabra de Dios y dar gracias a Dios a través de la comida eucarística. Idealmente, la palabra Ekklesia describe a los diversos miembros que componen la comunidad cristiana que están respondiendo al llamado de Dios a una vocación en la vida.

Mientras los niños que reciben su primera comunión en Santa Lucia caminan en procesión por el pasillo este y el próximo sábado, damos gracias a Dios por aquellos que están listos para recibir a Jesús con los brazos abiertos. La luz que estos niños recibieron cuando fueron bautizados todavía brilla con esplendor y da luz a sus ojos. Muchos de los niños tienen 7 años o más. Se han estado preparando este año para este día especial y estamos felices de apoyarlos con nuestras oraciones y buenos deseos. La primavera es una estación de renovación. Del mismo modo, el Tiempo Pascual es un momento apropiado para celebrar estos sacramentos de iniciación como una renovación de la fe y para revisar nuestra propia iniciación con aquellos recibidos más plenamente en la vida de la Iglesia. Que estas celebraciones sean para nosotros un tiempo de gracia y acción de gracias.



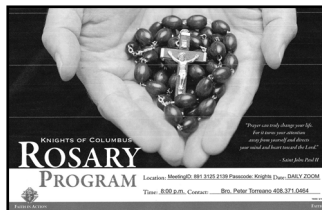

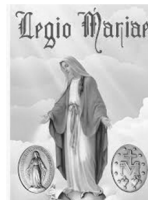
