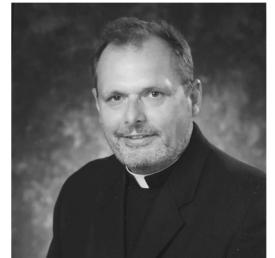
The mission of Saint Lucy Parish is to lead people to a transformative relationship with Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church. We live our faith by welcoming and serving.

Diocesan Synod

Among those who read the articles we publish in the bulletin; most will remember the response of St. Lucy parishioners who participated in the universal synodal process initiated by Pope Francis. We conducted the group sessions last spring after Easter and submitted our report to diocesan coordinators who included it with reports from parishes in the San Jose diocese. More recently, our newsletter included a link to the complete diocesan report sent to Rome.

Additionally, you may have read an article by Bishop Cantú that was published in the Valley Catholic Magazine and the Nation Catholic Reporter describing his experience as an invited guest to the first Ecclesial Assembly of the Church in Latin America. In that article he wrote: "I had been invited to the ecclesial assembly as one of a handful of in-person participants from the United States. (Seventy others from the U.S. participated online.) What I witnessed was not only fascinating, prayerful and engaging, it was a manifestation of the content and spirit of Lumen Gentium, particularly Chapter 2, "The People of God." It was an experience of ecclesial synodality at work." (Continued on page 5...)

Más recientemente, nuestro boletín incluyó un enlace al informe diocesano completo enviado a Roma.

Lo que presencié no solo fue fascinante, lleno de oración y atractivo, sino que fue una manifestación del contenido y el espíritu de Lumen Gentium, en particular el Capítulo 2, "El pueblo de Dios". 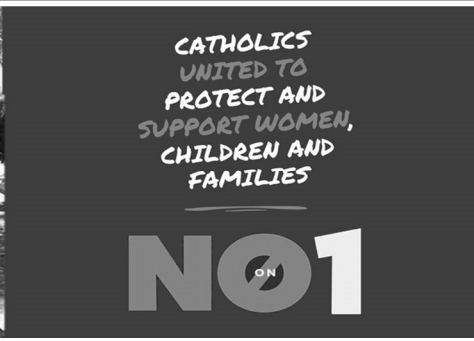

VOTE "NO" ON PROPOSITION 1

Proposition 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. It is an expensive and misleading ballot measure that allows unlimited late-term abortions — for any reason, at any time, even moments before birth, paid for by tax dollars.

Prop 1 isn't needed. Sadly, California already has some of the most permissive abortion laws in the nation that would remain in effect without the amendment, including our current limit on late-term abortions that are permitted only for the life and health of the mother. For those unfamiliar with the documents of Vatican II, the phrase that Bishop Cantú cites literally means “the light of the nations”. Bishop Cantú also expressed his uncertainty about participating in a process that included so many people and wondered how it was possible to create an environment where everyone’s voice would be heard. He feared that such a process would be chaotic and only produce an opportunity for people to voice their grievances. What he experienced was quite different from what he expected, and he commended those coordinating these efforts for bringing over 1000 people together for a well-organized event that allowed for real dialogue.

What if the members of the local Roman Catholic Churches in the diocese of San Jose could do the same? While the governance of the Church is not a democracy, one of the most enduring characteristics of Catholicism is that we are a conciliar Church. Given that we are One Holy Catholic Apostolic Church, from its very inception, those called to live as one body in Christ have made great efforts to seek harmony and build consensus. Some may describe this as the Sensus Fidelium that is the people who share in the prophetic ministry of Jesus through our baptism in him.

Accordingly, Bishop Cantú has initiated a Diocesan Synod for 2023. We have three delegates from St. Lucy Parish and School: Ms. Audrey Alvear Baez, Ms. Dora Jaramillo, and Mr. Tom Mormon. In the succeeding weeks, we will gather leaders of the parish and school for consultation, and we will keep you updated on future events.

Para quienes no estén familiarizados con los documentos del Vaticano II, la frase que cita el obispo Cantú significa literalmente “la luz de las naciones”. El obispo Cantú también expresó su incertidumbre por participar en un proceso que incluía a tantas personas y se preguntó cómo era posible crear un ambiente donde se escuchara la voz de todos. Temía que tal proceso sería caótico y solo generaría una oportunidad para que las personas expresaran sus quejas. Lo que experimentó fue bastante diferente de lo que esperaba, y elogió a quienes coordinaron estos esfuerzos por reunir a más de 1000 personas en un evento bien organizado que permitió un diálogo real.

¿Qué si los miembros de las iglesias católicas locales en la diócesis de San José pudieran hacer lo mismo? Aunque el gobierno de la Iglesia no es una democracia, una de las características más perdurables del catolicismo es que somos una Iglesia conciliar. Dado que somos Una Santa Iglesia Católica Apostólica, desde sus inicios, los llamados a vivir como un solo cuerpo en Cristo han hecho grandes esfuerzos para buscar la armonía y construir consensos. Algunos pueden describir esto como el Sensus Fidelium que son las personas que comparten el ministerio profético de Jesús a través de nuestro bautismo en él.

En consecuencia, el obispo Cantú ha iniciado un sínodo diocesano para 2023. Tenemos tres delegados de la parroquia y la escuela Santa Lucia: la Sra. Audrey Alvear Baez, la Sra. Dora Jaramillo y el Sr. Tom Mormon. En las próximas semanas, reuniremos a los líderes de la parroquia y la escuela para realizar consultas, y los mantendremos informados sobre eventos futuros.

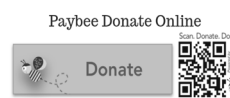

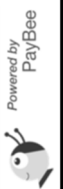

Message from the Principal

Jeff Christian, St. Lucy Alumni 84', Founder of C4 Leaders, and author of *We Rise Together, The Pizza Day Series* has shared his book with students, faculty and staff over the past several weeks. *We Rise Together, The Pizza Day Series* motivates readers through the pizza making process to facilitate communication, chemistry, consistency and creativity (C4).




In the book, the teacher, Mrs. Rock uses the pizza making process to teach her students to listen, trust, appreciate differences, show empathy and kindness and to see and develop greatness in each other. The "secret pizza recipe" has several steps and the first step is to make the dough. In order to make sourdough pizza dough, one must "Feed the Starter." Mrs. Rock correlates feeding the starter dough to taking care of ourselves. Mrs. Rock goes on to ask students what ingredients they need to grow healthy and strong both mentally and physically? She reminds them that when life gets busy we should P.B.S. (Pause, Breathe and Smile) and slow down. Keep life simple! Just like pizza has the dough as a foundation, we have to start at our foundation of taking care of ourselves. Once the foundation is built, "ingredients" can be added through building friendships and community.

Students were asked to "Feed their Starter" by coming up with a challenge for themselves that would motivate them to spend time together as family. The faculty and staff "Feed the Starter" with a challenge that encourages self-care. Each class and the faculty & staff were given sourdough starter kits. In class each morning, a student shares their personal challenge and feeds the starter. The students are having a great time watching their dough rise each day! St. Lucy families are also participating in a challenge, Feed the Starter Family Edition where they were asked to spend four meals together, making and enjoying dinner as a family.

Jeff has spent time with our faculty, staff, students and parents inspiring them, motivating them and challenging them to see a world of hope and kindness, where they lift themselves and others up and are reminded to simply slow down and do less-better.

Join us in the Feed your Starter Challenge. Set a goal and go for it! Remember to P.B.S and keep it simple.
