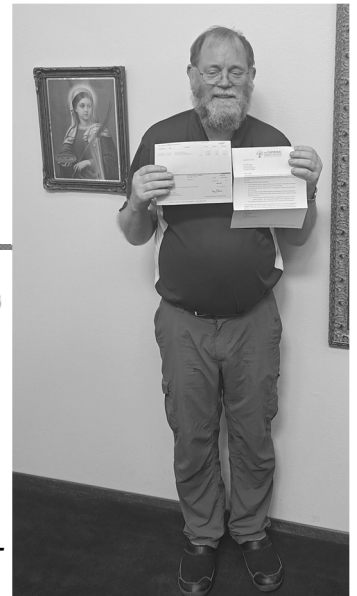

The third was for our young adult group and their work in reaching out through social media to their peers. The work of the Foundation is a great blessing to our local Church. You can support the work of the Church through donations to the Foundations endowments or to our St. Lucy Parish and School endowments established several years ago. As I write this article the news has come out that President Trump has contracted COVID-19. We recognize the human frailty that is exposed through sickness and especially during this pandemic. And we pray for his health and all those who are ill. It is important, as we continue our discussion on the Bishops' letter "Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship", we seek the common good and a common blessing for all members of our human family.

"We are one human family, whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences. We are our brothers' and sisters' keepers, wherever they may be. Loving our neighbor has global dimensions and requires us to eradicate racism and address the extreme poverty and disease plaguing so much of the world. Solidarity also includes the scriptural call to welcome the stranger among us—including immigrants seeking work—by ensuring that they have opportunities for a safe home, education for their children, and a decent life for their families and by ending the practice of separating families through deportation. In light of the Gospel's invitation to be peacemakers, our commitment to solidarity with our neighbors—at home and abroad—also demands that we promote peace and pursue justice in a world marred by terrible violence and conflict. Decisions on the use of force should be guided by traditional moral criteria and undertaken only as a last resort. As St. Paul VI taught, "If you want peace, work for justice" (World Day of Peace Message, January 1, 1972)." (#52)

Looking at candidates through the lens of the seamless garment of life and the promoting of peace and justice is indispensable. "We are our brothers' and sisters' keepers" and when we or a candidate we support choose to wish ill our seek harm to another we then have separated ourselves from the gift of life that God places in our souls. Thank you again for all of your blessings. **God Bless, Fr. Mark**
