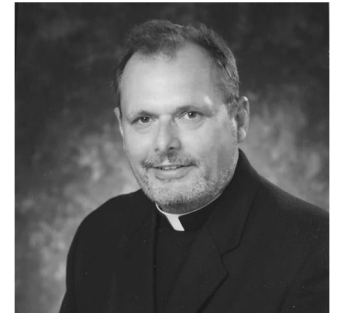

**Fr. Peace**

A recent conversation with a Catholic High School teacher reminded me of those early lessons from the Oakford Dominican Sisters and the archdiocesan Priests at St. Justin Parochial Elementary School. The teacher explained how his parish priest in South Dakota taught him to fish. That joggled the gears in my head and there came to mind all the fun days of altar server picnics and retreats. Fast forward to my days as a youth minister, I recall gathering for prayer in the morning and evening and learning to serve in ministry and leadership in a parish setting. Such are the hallmarks of priestly life, and their service of sanctifying, preaching, and teaching continues by our work today.



One whose memory remains fixed in my mind was a priest named Fr. Peace. It seemed a most fitting name for him as he seemed a most peaceful man—*nomen omen*. He would often spend time training the acolytes and preparing them to serve at a major liturgical event. (Continued on page 4...)

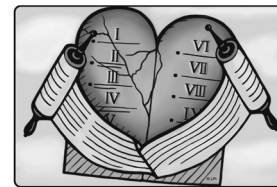

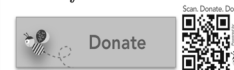

## (Pastor's Notes Continued from page 1)

He visited with students after school recruiting them for altar serving and asking them to consider being a priest or to join a religious order. He served as sacristan, celebrated the early morning Sunday Mass, preached in a soft but vocal tone, and was inclined to assist at each Sunday mass for the distribution of communion in a cassock and surplis. He was a quiet and enigmatic man.

He would not speak too much about his past, but the pastor of the parish knew his backstory. He told us the Fr. Peace was from Eastern Europe and lived as a parish priest in his town while it was occupied by Nazi Germany. He was sent to a concentration camp and worked there until the Russian Army liberated the camp. Not long after, he left Europe for America and moved to California and settled in the tenderloin of San Francisco. An archdiocesan priest ministering there happened to meet Fr. Peace but did not know he was a priest. He soon determined this and brought him to the Archbishop who confirmed that he was indeed a priest from Eastern Europe and asked if he would like to serve in the Archdiocese of San Francisco. From then on, Fr. Peace made his home in San Jose at Queen of the Apostles until his retirement and subsequent death some years ago.

Fr. Peace survived because he loved and believed in love's power. That's a lesson to give us pause in life's search for meaning. Names tell more about who we are than we might imagine. As the Latin proverb goes—*nomen omen*—the name is a sign. God calls each and everyone of us by name.

## (Notas del Párroco, de la pagina 1)

*Visitaba con los estudiantes después de la escuela, los reclutaba para servir en el altar y les pedía que consideraran ser sacerdotes o unirse a una orden religiosa. Se desempeñaba como sacristán, celebraba la misa dominical temprano en la mañana, predicaba en un tono suave y ayudaba en cada misa dominical para la distribución de la comunión con sotana y con exceso. Era un hombre tranquilo y enigmático.*

*No hablaba demasiado de su pasado, pero el párroco de la parroquia conocía su historia de fondo. Nos dijo que el Padre Peace era de Europa del Este y vivió como sacerdote en su pueblo mientras éste estaba ocupado por la Alemania Nazi. Lo enviaron a un campo de concentración y trabajó allí hasta que el ejército ruso liberó el campo. Poco después, dejó Europa para ir a América y se mudó a California y se instaló en San Francisco. Un sacerdote arquidiocesano que ministraba allí se encontró con el Padre Peace pero no sabía que era sacerdote. Pronto determinó esto y lo llevó ante el Arzobispo, quien confirmó que efectivamente era un sacerdote de Europa del Este y le preguntó si le gustaría servir en la Arquidiócesis de San Francisco. A partir de entonces, el Padre Peace hizo de San José su hogar en la Iglesia de Queen of Apostles hasta su retiro y posterior muerte hace algunos años.*

*El Padre Peace sobrevivió porque él amaba y creía en el poder del amor. Esa es una lección que nos hace hacer una pausa en la búsqueda de significado en la vida. Los nombres dicen más sobre quiénes somos de lo que imaginamos. Como dice el proverbio latino—*nomen omen*—el nombre es una señal. Dios nos llama a todos y cada uno de nosotros por nuestro nombre.*

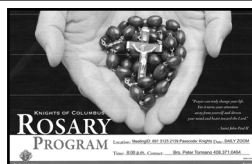
