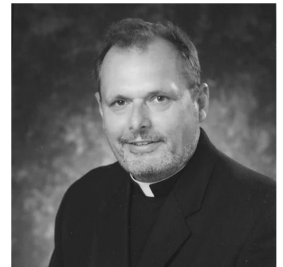

Looking Back

“Once you put your hand to the plow there’s no turning back.” Some biblical sayings are more memorable than others. This wise maxim came from a time when farmers used manual plows to till the soil into furrows. So long as the worker kept looking forward there was little chance for the plow to go astray. Looking back increased the chance for the plow to go off its natural course creating inefficiency and a chaotic pattern. If you want to look back, get a rearview mirror to keep looking forward.



Even though we do well to be mindful of the present moment as the only time we have, looking back is another way of marking progress. As humble as any human achievement may be, it remains a hallmark of human excellence. Achievement presents a paradigm shift—a new way of thinking. Discovery follows a different way of measuring what is true or false about previously held views. It helps to have a purpose in mind but suffice it say that achievement is a motivating force for anyone planning for the future, living in the present, and mindful about the past. Si quieres mirar hacia atrás, usa un espejo retrovisor para seguir mirando hacia adelante.

Aunque hacemos bien en ser conscientes del presente como el único tiempo que tenemos, mirar hacia atrás es otra forma de marcar el progreso. Por más humilde que pueda ser cualquier logro humano, sigue siendo un sello distintivo de la excelencia humana. El logro presenta un cambio, una nueva forma de pensar. El descubrimiento sigue una forma diferente de medir lo que es verdadero o falso sobre puntos de vista previos. Es útil tener un propósito en mente, pero baste decir que el logro es una fuerza motivadora para cualquier persona para planear el futuro, vivir en el presente y estar consciente del pasado. 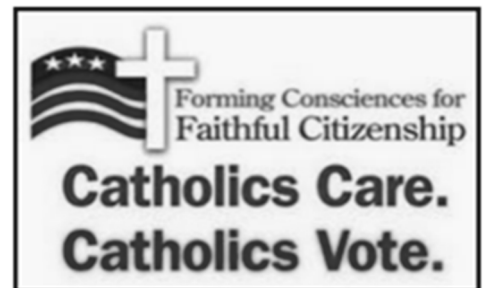

Paradigm shifts seem to happen with greater frequency as we age—perhaps it is the result of greater awareness of how rapidly life changes and how necessary it is for us to adapt. Everyday presents the opportunity of new inquiry, learning, and practicing ways of endeavoring to become more humane. To reminisce about the way things were our innocence as children; how exciting it was to form new friends, to rejoice with your success or accept support when you fail, these kinds of memories confirm our true character in the present and give us reason to hope for the future.

There is something to be said for putting one's hand to the plow. The actual scripture passage states, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of Heaven." The context from the gospel of Luke 9:62 describes the encounter between Jesus and a would-be follower and how to be fit for the Kingdom of God. Jesus presents a paradigm shift that continues to give us new insight. As Christians we believe that the Holy Spirit is our principle guide, and that each of us has a role to play as members of the body of Christ. All who have been baptized into Jesus are meant to keep our minds set on the horizon, and not let the past keep us from our destination.

Human achievement will continue to bring us closer to what is true. Looking back is best through a rearview mirror at past mile markers along the way.

Para recordar cómo eran las cosas de nuestra inocencia cuando éramos niños; que emocionante fue formar nuevos amigos, regocijarse con un éxito o aceptar apoyo cuando fallamos, este tipo de recuerdos confirman nuestro verdadero carácter en el presente y nos dan motivos para tener esperanza en el futuro.

Hay algo que decir acerca de poner la mano en el arado. El pasaje de las Escrituras dice: "El que pone la mano en el arado y sigue mirando atrás, no sirve para el reino de Dios". El contexto del evangelio de Lucas 9:62 describe el encuentro entre Jesús y un posible seguidor y cómo ser apto para el Reino de Dios. Jesús presenta un cambio de paradigma que continúa brindándonos una nueva perspectiva. Como cristianos creemos que el Espíritu Santo es nuestro principal guía y que cada uno tiene un papel que desempeñar como miembros del cuerpo de Cristo. Todos los que han sido bautizados en Jesús están destinados a mantener nuestras mentes en el horizonte y no permitir que el pasado nos aleje de nuestro destino.

Los logros humanos seguirán acercándonos a lo que es verdad. Mirar hacia atrás es mejor a través de un espejo retrovisor en los últimos marcadores de millas en el camino.

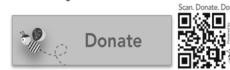
