The Examined Life

The ancient Greek philosopher Socrates asked questions about the nature of being human. His questions led him to believe that the examined life is far more meaningful than its opposite. This wise realization is an appealing idea because of its simplicity and nearly universal application. The examined life is essential for anyone pursuing spiritual life particularly for Christian Spirituality. To be able to articulate and distinguish between essence and being is a good entry point into a method for examining our human nature. Who am I? What is fundamental to humans? Every generation keeps these questions before them—finding the way to stay on the path that leads to truth. This eternal musing remains the catalyst for thought. Year after year, we may revisit these questions in order to give a new reply and distinguish the particular from the universal. Each life is unique. Uniqueness makes the examined life possible. There's a period for your intercessory prayers after which we'll pray the Our Father. Near the end of service you'll be invited to pray at the cross in whatever form you're comfortable with kneeling, touching, or standing by the cross. 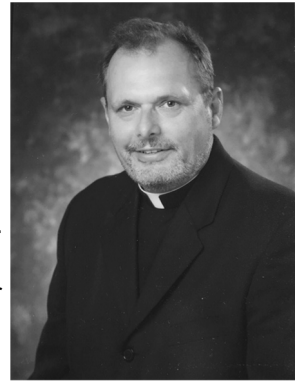

Every Jesuit is meant to prayerfully consider the day's events at set times of the day. For many in the order, practicing a daily *examen* provides a conscientious way to judge what events were good and those not so good. Many religious and lay alike have adopted this practice for its practical and prayerful qualities. Recognizing the good and bad events of life allows us to store the memories that make life worth living and helps us to heal the more difficult experiences of life. Indeed, even while the unpleasant experiences of life are not easily forgotten, such ought not deter anyone from examining life's events. The examined life brings to mind an unsurpassed wisdom, and it is vital for growing in full maturity as a follower of Christ.



In these waning days of summer, the growth we experience now will have resonance for the rest and recreation of winter. It will prepare us for the next harvest that comes with fall and the light and fluid air of spring. From one season to the next, we change. To acknowledge change as it occurs allow us to live in the present. As we live in the present we become more keenly aware of ourselves as unique individuals who acknowledge their part in the communal consciousness.

If the examined life is one worth living, then all do well to examine life daily. Yet, if it is so worthwhile, why then do so many lack time for the examined life? Life's meaning is an inexhaustible search as is the richness in meaning life can bring. Our time to search for life's meaning is limited, and the meaning we find in life can lead us to eternity.

The examined life is essential to our good health and spiritual well being.

Cada jesuita necesita considerar en oración los eventos diarios en momentos determinados del día. Para muchos de la orden, practicar un examen diario proporciona una forma concienzuda de juzgar qué eventos fueron buenos y cuáles no tan buenos. Muchos religiosos y laicos han adoptado esta práctica por sus cualidades prácticas y de oración. Reconocer los buenos y malos acontecimientos de la vida nos permite almacenar los recuerdos que hacen que la vida valga la pena y nos ayuda a sanar las experiencias más difíciles de la vida. De hecho, aunque las experiencias desagradables de la vida no se olvidan fácilmente, eso no debería disuadir a nadie de examinar los acontecimientos de la vida. La vida examinada trae a la mente una sabiduría insuperable, y es vital para crecer en plena madurez como seguidor de Cristo.

En estos últimos días de verano, el crecimiento que experimentamos ahora tendrá resonancia para el descanso y la recreación del invierno. Nos preparará para la próxima cosecha que llega con el otoño y el aire ligero y fluido de la primavera. De una temporada a la siguiente, cambiamos. Reconocer el cambio a medida que ocurre nos permite vivir en el presente. A medida que vivimos en el presente, nos volvemos más conscientes de nosotros mismos como individuos únicos que reconocen su parte en la conciencia comunitaria. Si la vida examinada es una que vale la pena vivir, entonces todos deberíamos examinar la vida a diario. Sin embargo, si vale la pena, ¿por qué a tantos les falta tiempo para la vida examinada? El sentido de la vida es una búsqueda inagotable al igual que la riqueza de sentido que la vida puede aportar. Nuestro tiempo para buscar el significado de la vida es limitado y el significado que encontramos en la vida puede llevarnos a la eternidad.

La vida examinada es esencial para nuestra buena salud y bienestar espiritual.

Low-income Santa Clara County residents who have been financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic can receive help paying rent. Assistance is available through two different programs:

All eligible renters are encouraged to apply for assistance. Both tenants and landlords may apply for either of these programs. for extremely low income residents who need help paying rent

To qualify, you must be a Santa Clara County resident who:

- ✓ Has been financially impacted by the pandemic;
- ✓ Is at-risk of losing your housing; AND
- ✓ Makes less than 30% of the area's median income (see income table to the right)

Eligible residents will receive assistance to help pay rent, and may also qualify for additional funds to meet other basic needs. The amount of assistance will be determined based on the individual household's situation and funding availability.

All eligible residents are encouraged to apply, and priority will go towards assisting the most vulnerable members of our community.

The Santa Clara County Homelessness Prevention System - COVID-19 Response is a unique public-private partnership committed to assisting at-risk families and individuals maintain their housing. This initiative is a collaboration between close to 50 different organizations, and is being led by Destination Home, Sacred Heart Community Service, the County of Santa Clara, the City of San Jose and Silicon Valley Strong.

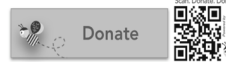

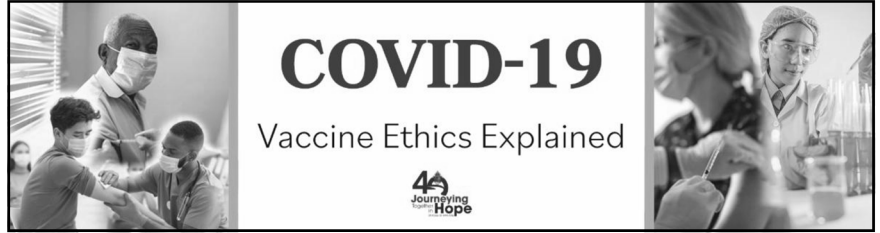

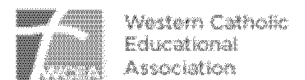
