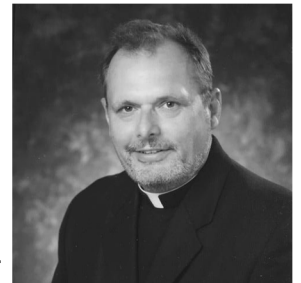

The Harvest Is Plenty

“Other seeds fell into the good soil, and as they grew up and increased, they yielded a crop and produced thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold.” And He was saying, “He who has ears to hear, let him hear.”

This passage from Mark chapter 4 describes a fruitful harvest. In the first part of this parable, the farmer sows seed inconsistently as many of them fall in places unsuitable for growth. Jesus uses parables to teach and often employed agrarian themes. The first century Christians would have delighted in these stories. They were aware of how much effort was required for producing food, and they understood the allegorical message that Jesus wanted to convey. Jesus would use agrarian images to keep those listening interested in what he taught and how it would impact their lives.

Some within our community understand the agrarian life better than others. Most of us shop for food at the grocery store. It is hard for us to imagine the way farmers produce and harvest our food because we are less likely to produce it our own. (Continued on page 5...)



La Cosecha es Abundante

“Otras semillas cayeron en buena tierra, y crecieron, dando una buena cosecha; algunas espigas dieron treinta granos por semilla, otras sesenta granos, y otras cien”. Y añadió Jesús: Los que tiene oídos, oigan.”

Este pasaje del capítulo 4 de San Marcos describe una cosecha fructífera. En la primera parte de esta parábola, el agricultor siembra semillas de manera inconsistente ya que muchas de ellas caen en lugares inadecuados para el crecimiento. Jesús usa parábolas para enseñar y, a menudo, emplea temas agrarios. Estas historias les encantaban a los cristianos del primer siglo. Eran conscientes del esfuerzo que se requería para producir alimentos y comprendían el mensaje que Jesús quería transmitir. Jesús usaría imágenes agrarias para mantener a los que escuchaban interesados en lo que enseñaba y cómo impactaría en sus vidas.

Algunos dentro de nuestra comunidad entienden la vida agraria mejor que otros. La mayoría de nosotros compramos comida en el supermercado. Es difícil para nosotros imaginar la forma en que los agricultores producen y cosechan nuestros alimentos porque es menos probable que los produzcamos nosotros mismos. (Continúa en la página 5...)

The terrain we work is quite different but no less capable of producing thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold. The people who inhabit this land are ready for the harvest though there are not enough laborers. Jesus tells it this way, **"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."** If you imagined that as a call to ministry by following a vocation of service to God, then you understand the allegory well.

Many that attend Mass on a regular basis usually find it difficult to involve themselves in the various activities of parish life. Some have heard or read that we need additional Eucharistic Ministers and lectors for the Sunday Mass or a plea for volunteers to assist with livestreaming. It is not so easy to find oneself in a role of ministry or leadership in the parish even while the talent exists among those in the assembly. It requires vision and the willingness to pursue volunteer service at a parish.

Accordingly, for those who want to learn more about becoming lectors or Eucharistic Ministers, I encourage you to join us for a workshop on Saturday, December 3 from 9am to 12pm in the Church. Parish leaders will be present to give instructions to interested parishioners on how to be of service at Sunday Masses as a lector or Eucharistic Minister. If you are interested in these ministries, please make plans to join us on Saturday December 3.

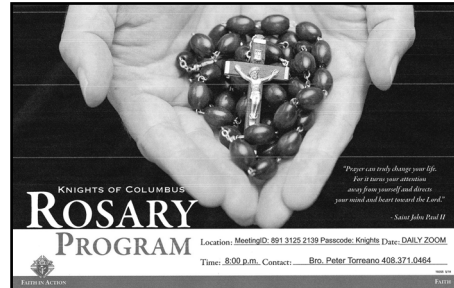

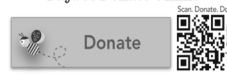
