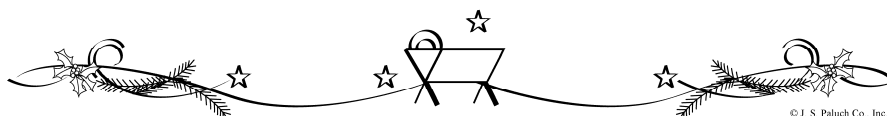

We are born into this world with the life that God breaths in us. What we choose sets the course for our lives. When the angel Gabriel announces to Mary the promise of God's mercy and favor for her and the opportunity to make a reply, Mary says yes and presents herself as the maidservant of God. Once having answered yes to God, Mary's life is changed forever. As the first disciple of her son, she remained faithful to him all her life.

Choosing to say yes to God has profound consequences. Mary becomes the mother of our salvation, but she also must face the struggle of witnessing her son's arrest, conviction, and crucifixion. Nevertheless, she believes in the fulfillment of God's promise, and her example of faith becomes a model for us to follow, particularly when we are unsure. When praying the Rosary, we are mindful of Mary's intercession on our behalf.

As we move from Advent to Christmas, from Christmas to the New Year, on to the Epiphany, and baptism of the Lord, let us keep in mind the story of Christ's birth and the faith Mary reveals. God chose her, and God chooses us. We have the advantage of hearing the words of scriptures that make us aware of our own manner and character as we seek the way of Christian faith that will lead us to eternal life.

Our celebration of Christmas is sustained by our faith in Christ. We seek to become his disciples. May we listen to the call of God in our lives that will ultimately lead us to service, love and peace. These things are possible for us because all things are possible with God. On behalf of the staff and faculty of St. Lucy Community, here's wishing you joy on this last Sunday of Advent.

Nacemos en este mundo con la vida que Dios sopla en nosotros. Lo que elegimos marca el rumbo de nuestras vidas. Cuando el ángel Gabriel anuncia a María la promesa de la misericordia y el favor de Dios con ella y la oportunidad de responder, María dice que sí y se presenta como la sierva de Dios. Una vez que ha respondido sí a Dios, la vida de María cambia para siempre. Como primera discípula de su hijo, le fue fiel durante toda su vida.

Elegir decir sí a Dios tiene profundas consecuencias. María se convierte en la madre de nuestra salvación, pero también debe enfrentar la lucha de presenciar el arresto, la condena y la crucifixión de su hijo. Sin embargo, ella cree en el cumplimiento de la promesa de Dios, y su ejemplo de fe se convierte en un modelo a seguir para nosotros, especialmente cuando no estamos seguros. Al rezar el Rosario, tenemos presente la intercesión de María por nosotros.

Mientras pasamos del Adviento a la Navidad, de la Navidad al Año Nuevo, a la Epifanía y al bautismo del Señor, tengamos en mente la historia del nacimiento de Cristo y la fe que revela María. Dios la eligió a ella, y Dios nos elige a nosotros. Tenemos la ventaja de escuchar las palabras de las Escrituras que nos hacen conscientes de nuestra propia manera y carácter mientras buscamos el camino de la fe cristiano que nos llevará a la vida eterna.

Nuestra celebración de la Navidad se sostiene en nuestra fe en Cristo. Buscamos convertirnos en sus discípulos. Que podamos escuchar el llamado de Dios en nuestras vidas que finalmente nos llevará al servicio, el amor y la paz. 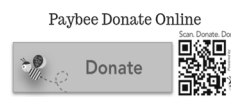

THE ADVENT WREATH

Today, we lit the second candle in the Advent Wreath. Traditionally, each of the four candles in the Advent Wreath have a deeper meaning:

- ◆ The **1st Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Hope with the "Prophet's Candle" reminding us that Jesus is coming.
- ◆ The **2nd Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Faith with the "Bethlehem Candle" reminding us of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem.
- ◆ The **3rd Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Joy with the "Shepherd's Candle" reminding us of the Joy the world is experienced at the coming birth of Jesus.
- ◆ The **4th Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Peace with the "Angel's Candle" reminding us of the message of the angels: "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men."



LA CORONA DE ADVIENTO

Hoy, encendimos la segunda vela en la Corona de Adviento. Tradicionalmente, cada una de las cuatro velas en la corona de Adviento tienen un significado más profundo:

- El **Primer Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Esperanza con la "Vela del Profeta" recordándonos que Jesús viene.
- El **Segundo Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Fe con la "Vela de Belén" que nos recuerda el viaje de María y José a Belén.
- El **Tercer Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Alegría con la "Vela del Pastor", recordándonos la alegría que experimenta el mundo en la proximidad del nacimiento de Jesús.
- El **Cuarto Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Paz con la "Vela del Ángel" recordándonos el mensaje de los ángeles: "Paz en la Tierra a los Hombres de Buena Voluntad."

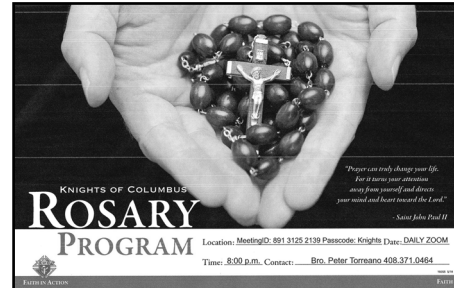

GOD WANTS TO BE ONE WITH US

What great lengths God will go to in loving and saving us! Think of the most outlandish circumstance you might conceive. That seems to be what the Lord is saying to Ahaz in today's first reading. "A virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel." Not only is the idea of a virgin conceiving beyond comprehension in Ahaz's time, so would the concept of God wanting to be with us be, as the name Emmanuel indicates. And yet, this is what we celebrate in the Incarnation—God wants so completely to be one with us that God came to be with us in a son born to a virgin, the Blessed Virgin Mary.
