**Life's Endless Pursuit**

Some years ago, I heard an administrator addressing a group of parents at Archbishop Mitty High School. Many of the parents complained that their children's schedules were overwrought with too many extracurricular activities to successfully complete the academic demands of their teachers. His answer to this eternal grievance: if you want something done, ask a busy person. He quoted a study that demonstrated an increased academic success rate among students capable of arranging their time to be involved in a diversity of activities. While this may be true for some, it seems at best paradoxical and counter intuitive.



Albeit, in theory at least, a physical principle parallels this idea: a body in motion tends to stay in motion. People who organize and plan their lives can fulfill what they intend—perhaps more successfully than those less inclined to do so. Regardless of how busy a person is, I don't believe that anyone of us can do more than one thing at a time. (Continued on page 5...)

*Hace algunos años, escuché a un administrador dirigirse a un grupo de padres en la escuela secundaria Archbishop Mitty. Muchos de los padres se quejaron de que los horarios de sus hijos estaban sobrecargados con demasiadas actividades extracurriculares para poder completar con éxito las demandas académicas de sus maestros. Su respuesta a este eterno agravio: si quieres que se haga algo, pregúntale a una persona ocupada. Citó un estudio que demostró una mayor tasa de éxito académico entre los estudiantes capaces de organizar su tiempo para participar en una diversidad de actividades. Aunque, esto puede ser cierto para algunos, en el mejor de los casos parece paradójico y contrario a la intuición.*

*Aunque, al menos en teoría, un principio físico es paralelo a esta idea: un cuerpo en movimiento tiende a permanecer en movimiento. Las personas que organizan y planifican sus vidas pueden cumplir con lo que se proponen, tal vez con más éxito que las que están menos inclinadas a hacerlo. Independientemente de lo ocupada que esté una persona, no creo que ninguno de nosotros pueda hacer más de una cosa a la vez. (Continúa en la página 5...)*

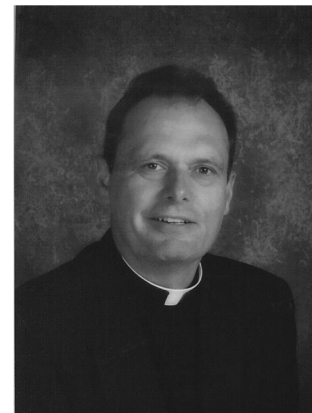

Donovan—a somewhat famous pop singer from the 60's—composed songs for the film directed by Franco Zeffirelli "Brother Sun, Sister Moon." In one of the songs, the lyric states, "if you want to live life free take your time go slowly-do few things but do them well-heartfelt work grows purely."

Apart from being a busy person, we do well to work for what is valuable by focusing on what has the most resonance and importance. Having vision and working to complete the goals that improve our lives and the lives of those near to us is very much in keeping with Jesus' understanding of God's reign among us. It is edifying to read about the many named and unnamed parishioners that built this Church into what it is today. There is still much more that we can achieve, even while obstacles still exists. A busy person is limited too, but when we work with others, these limitations give way to a communal effort and mutual success.

That school administrator was right and so are the lyrics from Donovan's song. Great things happen when many events coalesce to bring about a higher consciousness for truth and what will serve the good of all people. Fundamentally, our species depends upon this cooperative effort to bring about the communal good we hold and trust. Ultimately, we attribute all of these works to God. As we embark on another Advent season, I pray this year we will be an example to future generations by generously and willingly accepting and acknowledging what a privilege it is to serve in this community of faith. May each answer God's call and attend to the vision it lends for our future.

#### THE ADVENT WREATH

Today, we lit the second candle in the Advent Wreath. Traditionally, each of the four candles in the Advent Wreath have a deeper meaning:

- ◆ The **1st Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Hope with the "Prophet's Candle" reminding us that Jesus is coming.
- ◆ The **2nd Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Faith with the "Bethlehem Candle" reminding us of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem.
- ◆ The **3rd Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Joy with the "Shepherd's Candle" reminding us of the Joy the world is experienced at the coming birth of Jesus.
- ◆ The **4th Sunday of Advent** symbolizes Peace with the "Angel's Candle" reminding us of the message of the angels: "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men."



#### LA CORONA DE ADVIENTO

Hoy, encendimos la segunda vela en la Corona de Adviento. Tradicionalmente, cada una de las cuatro velas en la corona de Adviento tienen un significado más profundo:

- El **Primer Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Esperanza con la "Vela del Profeta" recordándonos que Jesús viene.
- El **Segundo Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Fe con la "Vela de Belén" que nos recuerda el viaje de María y José a Belén.
- El **Tercer Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Alegría con la "Vela del Pastor", recordándonos la alegría que experimenta el mundo en la proximidad del nacimiento de Jesús.
- El **Cuarto Domingo de Adviento** simboliza la Paz con la "Vela del Ángel" recordándonos el mensaje de los ángeles: "Paz en la Tierra a los Hombres de Buena Voluntad ."

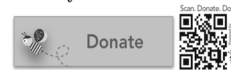
