## (Pastor's Notes Continued from page 1)

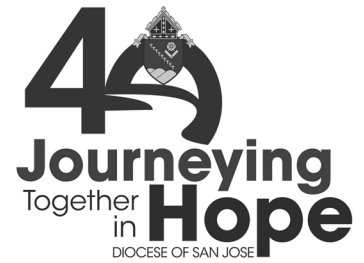
The theme of our ADA is "**Journeying Together in Hope.**" These were words I reflected on over the past week. How have we as the Diocese of San Jose Journeyed Together in Hope? We cannot ignore the reality of our inability to do what we would like to do as the Catholic Church. We can often feel stifled in preaching the Gospel message. It can be difficult to see hope in the darkness of our times.

I shared in my ADA letter three areas where hope has blossomed in the partnership of the diocese with our parish...the helping to stay in contact with you, the caring for those in need of a helping hand with food and the seeking to help those suffering the mental and social strains of isolation and other stresses in their life.

Why do we need to support the Annual Diocesan Appeal this year more than ever? First and foremost it is a tangible and living sign of our unity with Bishop Cantú and his ministry in the Diocese of San Jose. But, for me as your pastor, it is the reality that we, as a parish, cannot do this alone, we must be united in looking forward to a vision of what we are called to be and do as the Catholic Church in Santa Clara County in the years to come. One of the lessons, we as a Church, have needed to learn during the pandemic is our inter-reliance on each other. Some parishes have been able to do more than others, while other parishes have been able focus on special ministries that stretch beyond their normal ministry. "**Journeying Together in Hope,**" and our support of the mission of the Diocese and Bishop Cantú helps us to do God's work in encountering Jesus in our neighbor.

I know we can at times be frustrated with our Catholic Church, but I would challenge you to look beyond these frustrations and see the blessing of journeying together to the future filled with faith, hope and charity. I have already pledge, please join me in supporting the Annual Diocesan Appeal.

No podemos ignorar la realidad de nuestra incapacidad para hacer lo que nos gustaría hacer como Iglesia Católica. A menudo podemos sentirnos sofocados en la predicación del mensaje del Evangelio. Puede ser difícil ver la esperanza en la oscuridad de nuestro tiempo.*

*Compartí en mi carta de la ADA tres áreas en las que la esperanza ha florecido la asociación de la diócesis con nuestra parroquia ... la ayuda para permanecer en contacto con ustedes, el cuidado de los que necesitan ayuda con la comida y la búsqueda de ayudar a los que sufren las tensiones mentales y sociales del aislamiento y otras tensiones en su vida.*

*¿Por qué necesitamos apoyar la Campaña Diocesana Anual este año más que nunca? Ante todo, es un signo vivo y tangible de nuestra unidad con el Obispo Cantú y su ministerio en la Diócesis de San José. Pero, para mí, como su párroco, es la realidad de que nosotros, como parroquia, no podemos hacer esto solos, debemos estar unidos esperando una visión de lo que estamos llamados a ser y hacer como Iglesia Católica en el Condado de Santa Clara en los próximos años. Una de las lecciones que nosotros, como Iglesia, hemos tenido que aprender durante la pandemia es nuestra interdependencia con otros. Algunas parroquias han podido hacer más que otras, mientras que otras parroquias han podido enfocarse en ministerios especiales que van más allá de su ministerio normal. ### **A NEW DAY DAWNS**

Today we hear how Jonah, sent by God to warn the people, storms through the streets of Nineveh, scaring the citizens out of their wits. And it works! God has a change of heart, seeing "by their actions" how the people turn from evil (Jonah 3:10). A new day dawns.

Next we hear Paul telling the Corinthians, "The world in its present form is passing away" (1 Corinthians 7:31). He calls for a change of heart. Stopping short of telling them to stop carrying out their everyday activities, he urges them—rather mysteriously—to live "as though" they aren't doing the things they are doing. A new day has dawned.

Finally, Jesus stands on the shore and cries, "The kingdom of God is at hand!" (Mark 1:14). Simon and Andrew abandon their nets—and even their father—and follow him. A new day had dawned.

Everyone has to change when a new day dawns: the Ninevites, the Corinthians, the apostles, even Jesus! Didn't a new day dawn today for us as well? Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

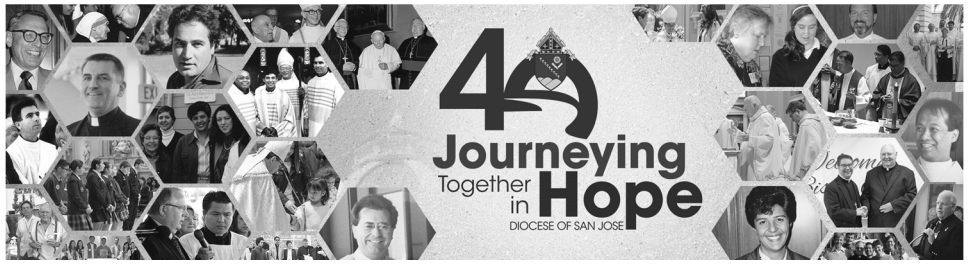
