This coming Wednesday, Ash Wednesday, marks the beginning of our Lenten journey. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, we are asked to make one more adaption...the marking of our foreheads will not happen but rather the ancient tradition of sprinkling the ashes upon the top of our head will be done this year.

The below article is from Fr. Jeff Fernandez the pastor of Queen of Apostles parish:

"The liturgical use of ashes originated in the Old Testament times (Esther 4:1; Job 42:6; Daniel 9:3; Jonah 3:5-6). Ashes symbolized mourning, mortality, and penance. The Old Testament examples give us evidence both a recognized practice of using ashes and a common understanding of their symbolism. Jesus himself also made reference to ashes (Matthew 11:21). The early Church continued the usage of ashes for the same symbolic reasons. (Continued on page 5...)

"El uso litúrgico de las cenizas se originó en los tiempos del Antiguo Testamento (Ester 4: 1; Job 42: 6; Daniel 9: 3; Jonás 3: 5-6). Las cenizas simbolizan el duelo, la mortalidad y la penitencia. Los ejemplos del Antiguo Testamento nos dan evidencia tanto de una práctica reconocida de usar cenizas como de un entendimiento común de su simbolismo. Jesús mismo también hizo referencia a las cenizas (Mateo 11:21). La Iglesia primitiva continuó usando cenizas por las mismas razones simbólicas. (Continúa en la página 5...)



For Ash Wednesday, Vatican Asks Priests to 'Sprinkle' Ashes on Heads. The Vatican Congregation for Divine Worship and the Sacraments asked priests to take special anti-COVID-19 precautions this year when distributing ashes on Ash Wednesday, Feb. 17, including sprinkling ashes on the top of people's heads rather than using them to make a cross on people's foreheads.

In his book, *De Poenitentia*, Tertullian (c. 160-220) prescribed that the penitent must “live without joy in the roughness of sackcloth and the squalor of ashes.” Eusebius (260-340), the famous early Church historian, recounted in his “The History of the Church” how an apostate named Natalis came to Pope Zephyrinus clothed in sackcloth and ashes begging forgiveness. Also, during this time, for those who were required to do public penance, the priest sprinkled ashes on the head of the person leaving confession. In the Middle Ages (8th century), those who were about to die were laid on the ground on top of sackcloth sprinkled with ashes. All of these examples, the symbolism of mourning, mortality, and penance is clear. Eventually, the use of ashes was adapted to mark the beginning of Lent, the 40-day preparation period (not including Sundays) for Easter. The ritual for the “Day of Ashes” is found in the earliest editions of the Gregorian Sacramentary which dates at least to the 8th century. Since the Middle Ages, the Church has used ashes to mark the beginning of the penitential season of Lent, when we remember our mortality and mourn for our sins. In our present liturgy for Ash Wednesday, we use ashes made from the burned palm branches distributed on the Palm Sunday of the previous year. The priest blesses the ashes and imposes them on the foreheads of the faithful, making the sign of the cross and saying, “Remember, that are dust, and to dust you shall return,” or “Repent, and believe in the Gospel.” When we begin the holy season of Lent in preparation for Easter, we must remember the significance of the ashes we have received: We mourn and do penance for our sins. We again convert our hearts to the Lord, who suffered, died, and rose for our salvation. We renew the promises made at our baptism, when we died to an old life and rose to a new life with Christ. Finally, mindful that the kingdom of this world passes away, we strive to live the kingdom of God now and look forward to its fulfillment in heaven”

En su libro, De Poenitentia, Tertuliano (c. 160-220) prescribe que el penitente debe "vivir sin alegría en la aspereza del cilicio y la miseria de las cenizas". Eusebio (260-340), el famoso historiador de la Iglesia primitiva, relató en su "Historia de la Iglesia" cómo un apóstata llamado Natalis llegó al Papa Zephyrinus vestido de cilicio y cenizas pidiendo perdón. Además, durante este tiempo, para quienes debían hacer penitencia pública, el sacerdote rociaba cenizas sobre la cabeza de la persona que dejaba la confesión. En la Edad Media (siglo VIII), los que estaban a punto de morir eran tendidos en el suelo sobre cilicio espolvoreado con cenizas. En todos estos ejemplos, el simbolismo del duelo, la mortalidad y la penitencia es claro. Finalmente, el uso de cenizas se adaptó para marcar el comienzo de la Cuaresma, el período de preparación de 40 días (sin incluir los domingos) para la Pascua. El ritual del "Día de las Cenizas" se encuentra en las primeras ediciones del Sacramentario Gregoriano que data al menos del siglo VIII. Desde la Edad Media, la Iglesia ha utilizado las cenizas para marcar el inicio del tiempo penitencial de la Cuaresma, cuando recordamos nuestra mortalidad y lloramos por nuestros pecados. En nuestra liturgia actual del Miércoles de Ceniza, utilizamos cenizas de las ramas de palma quemadas del Domingo de Ramos del año anterior. El sacerdote bendice las cenizas y las impone en la frente de los fieles, haciendo la señal de la cruz y diciendo: "Recuerda, que es polvo y al polvo volverás", o "Arrepiéntanse y crea en el Evangelio". Cuando comenzamos la temporada santa de Cuaresma en preparación para la Pascua, debemos recordar el significado de las cenizas que hemos recibido: lamentamos y hacemos penitencia por nuestros pecados. Nuevamente convertimos nuestros corazones al Señor, quien sufrió, murió y resucitó por nuestra salvación. Renovamos las promesas hechas en nuestro bautismo, cuando dejamos la una vida vieja y resucitamos a una nueva vida con Cristo. Finalmente, conscientes de que el reino de este mundo pasa, nos esforzamos por vivir el reino de Dios ahora y esperamos su cumplimiento en el cielo " **Que Dios los bendiga, el Padre Mark**
