The question and hopefully the reflections shared will help us to understand God's love for each of us and how when we seek freedom from sin we begin to share the gift of forgiveness with greater joy. The reality of an all-loving God at the heart of our faith will challenge us to not take for granted or presume mercy and forgiveness.

The second evening of our retreat will focus on mercy and how we find mercy and act in mercy with our brothers and sisters. Looking at the basic definition; **"Mercy is "the loving kindness, compassion, or forbearance shown to one who offends."** How do I accept the mercy of God? How do I share this mercy with others? We cannot understand mercy apart from forgiveness nor forgiveness apart from mercy. They are to peas in the same pod and must always be united. Looking at how fear can separate us from God and the community this night is an invitation into a greater appreciation of confessing our sins and bringing a clean heart to our relationships and commitment to love.

The last evening will be recognizing what sin is and what our sins are in our lives. **Learning how to prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation by making an examination of conscience.** This evening will remind us that Reconciliation is not about shame or guilt but about the liberation from these realities and entering into relationships of hope, grace and peace.

Please mark off these three evenings on your calendar. Make mercy and forgiveness a priority this Lent.

*La segunda noche de nuestro retiro se centrará en la misericordia y en cómo encontramos misericordia y actuamos en misericordia con nuestros hermanos y hermanas. Mirando la definición básica; **"La misericordia es" la bondad amorosa, la compasión o la paciencia que se muestra al que ofende "**. ¿Cómo acepto la misericordia de Dios? ¿Cómo comparto esta misericordia con los demás? No podemos entender la misericordia sin el perdón ni el perdón sin la misericordia. Son como guisantes en la misma vaina y siempre deben estar unidos. Mirando cómo el miedo puede separarnos de Dios y de la comunidad esta noche es una invitación a una mayor apreciación de confesar nuestros pecados y traer un corazón limpio a nuestras relaciones y compromiso con el amor.*

*La última noche será reconocer qué es el pecado y cuáles son nuestros pecados en nuestras vidas. **Aprender a prepararse para el Sacramento de la Reconciliación mediante un examen de conciencia.** Esta noche nos recordará que la Reconciliación no se trata de vergüenza o culpa, sino de liberarse de estas realidades y entablar relaciones de esperanza, gracia y paz.*

Marque estas tres noches en su calendario. Haga de la misericordia y el perdón una prioridad en esta Cuaresma.

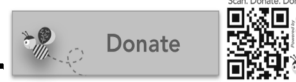

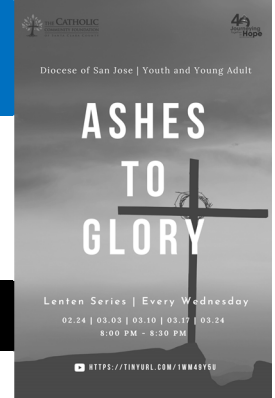

CRS Rice Bowl

A Story of Hope from Madagascar



Half of all children in Madagascar are undernourished, meaning they don't have enough nutritious food to stay healthy. Parents want their children to grow up healthy and strong, and the puppet shows give them new knowledge they can use right away to make sure that happens. Community health workers trained by CRS use the puppets to teach families about how doctor visits, hand washing and *rainbow* foods—different colored foods like tomatoes and carrots that have important vitamins and nutrients—are necessary to stay healthy.

Frankline and Labaladezy have eight children. Their youngest child, Thorin, is almost a year old. While Frankline was pregnant with Thorin, she and her husband Labaladezy watched the puppet shows and learned new ways to support Thorin's growth and development. When Thorin was born, his parents fed him different, more nutritious foods and took him to the health center for regular check-ups. Thorin is growing a lot and is reaching all his developmental milestones.

Frankline is happy her youngest son is doing so well, and she sees the positive effects of their new rainbow diet on the rest of the family. She says, "I dream that my children will stay healthy. I hope that Thorin may become a doctor or a leader in our community." Every parent wants their children to reach their full potential, and CRS is helping make sure they can do just that.

Una historia de esperanza de Madagascar

La mitad de todos los niños de Madagascar están desnutridos, lo que significa que no tienen suficientes alimentos nutritivos para mantenerse saludables. Los padres quieren que sus hijos crezcan sanos y fuertes, y los espectáculos de marionetas les brindan nuevos conocimientos que pueden usar de inmediato para asegurarse de que eso suceda. Los trabajadores de salud comunitarios capacitados por CRS usan los títeres para enseñar a las familias cómo las visitas al médico, el lavado de manos y los alimentos arcoíris (alimentos de diferentes colores como tomates y zanahorias que tienen importantes vitaminas y nutrientes) son necesarios para mantenerse saludables.

Frankline y Labaladezy tienen ocho hijos. Su hijo menor, Thorin, tiene casi un año. Mientras Frankline estaba embarazada de Thorin, ella y su esposo Labaladezy vieron los espectáculos de títeres y aprendieron nuevas formas de apoyar el crecimiento y desarrollo de Thorin. Cuando nació Thorin, sus padres lo alimentaron con alimentos diferentes y más nutritivos y lo llevaron al centro de salud para chequeos regulares. Thorin está creciendo mucho y está alcanzando todos sus hitos de desarrollo.

Frankline está feliz de que su hijo menor esté tan bien y ve los efectos positivos de su nueva dieta arcoíris en el resto de la familia. Ella dice: "Sueño que mis hijos se mantengan sanos. Espero que Thorin se convierta en médico o líder en nuestra comunidad". Todos los padres quieren que sus hijos alcancen su máximo potencial y CRS está ayudando a asegurarse de que puedan hacer precisamente eso.



(Rice with Greens)
Makes 4-5 servings

- 2 T fair trade olive oil
- 1 small onion, diced
- 1 medium tomato, diced
- 1 clove garlic
- 1 t fresh ginger, minced
- 3 c packed collard greens or kale
- 1 c rice
- 2 c water
- Salt and pepper to taste



Heat oil in medium-sized pot. Add onion, tomato, garlic and ginger, and sauté until just tender. Add collard greens or kale, and stir 1 minute. Add rice, water, salt and pepper. Bring to a boil. Cover and cook on medium heat for 25 minutes or until water is absorbed.

(Arroz con Verduras Verdes)
Rinde 4-5 porciones

- 2 cucharadas de aceite de oliva de comercio justo
- 1 cebolla pequeña, cortada en cubitos
- 1 tomate mediano, cortado en cubitos
- 1 diente de ajo
- 1 cucharada de jengibre fresco, picado
- 3 tazas de berza o col rizada
- 1 taza de arroz
- 2 c de agua
- Sal y pimienta para probar

Caliente el aceite en una olla mediana. Agregue la cebolla, el tomate, el ajo y el jengibre y saltee hasta que estén tiernos. Agregue las hojas de berza o la col rizada y revuelva durante 1 minuto. Agregue arroz, agua, sal y pimienta. Llevar a ebullición. Tape y cocine a fuego medio durante 25 minutos o hasta que se absorba el agua.

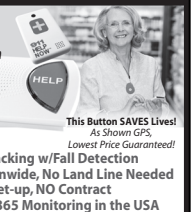
