Progress

Slowly but surely, things seem to be returning to normal, even as the COVID virus is something all of us will have

to abide as it is here to stay. Like any virus, once it forms and takes hold in human population, the potential for infection remains, regardless of vaccines or new treatments. Well documented historic events like the bubonic plague in medieval Europe, the influenza outbreak in the early part of the 20th century, or the AIDS epidemic of the 1980's can teach us something about the behavior of social groups and their approach to the crisis associated with pandemics. Being in the eye of the storm it's hard telling how well this is progressing because there are so many unknowns.

History documents the changes in social behaviors and patterns during times of crisis like pandemics. The one we experience and the way we react to it is uniquely different from any other in our history. One of those differences may be our response to the present events unfolding before the world. Many reports are marked by mendacity and purposely meant to deceive. (Continued on page 5....)



Progreso

Lento pero seguro, las cosas parecen volver a la normalidad, aunque parece que el virus COVID es algo que todos tendremos que soportar, ya que llegó para quedarse. Como cualquier virus, una vez que se forma y se afianza en la población humana, el potencial de infección permanece, independientemente de las vacunas o los nuevos tratamientos. El que experimentamos y la forma en que reaccionamos es singularmente diferente a cualquier otro en nuestra historia. Una de esas diferencias puede ser nuestra respuesta a los eventos presentes que se desarrollan ante el mundo. Muchos informes están marcados por la mentira y con el propósito de engañar. 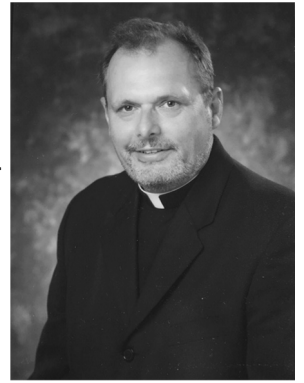

It's always happened as Lincoln was said to have coined "you can fool all of the people some of the time", but now it's happening on an unprecedented scale. Anyone with a Wi-Fi connection can summon the rage of an opposing position that only serves to exacerbate the divisions we are witnessing within just about every institution and system that has allowed us to progress in ways that other cultures have failed.

The more endearing and enduring behaviors among the human population in times of crisis is our capacity for understanding the importance of our relationships; especially those who need our care the most. They remind us that we are not built for isolation and how we do well to support those in most need or to accept the support of others when in need. This is the basis of social trust--that in any crisis, we ready ourselves to be of service to others. Those who have these characteristics in mind can manage through chaos or crisis by living one moment at a time and taking care of what is most important.

Trusting is essential to any human endeavor but most especially when we intend to work together in any project. The pandemic has stymied the efforts of many to work together for the good we can bring to bear in our parish community, this town of Campbell, and our region. There is no telling how long we will need to remain vigilant regarding transmissibility, but I've discussed these matters with parish leadership and we intend to re-engage the members of this community as we progress into the fall and winter months. For that we are praying that God will help us to call volunteers and ministers back to service in the community for the good of all.

There are many unknowns and many feel vulnerable right now. As faithful members of God's family may we endeavor to help one another through this time and find new ways to serve God and one another.

Siempre ha sucedido como Lincoln dijo "puedes engañar a toda la gente en algún momento", pero ahora está sucediendo a una gran escala. Cualquiera con una conexión Wi-Fi puede provocar una posición opuesta que solo sirve para exacerbar las divisiones que estamos presenciando dentro de casi todas las instituciones y sistemas que nos han permitido progresar en formas en las que otras culturas han fallado.

Los comportamientos más durables de la población humana en tiempos de crisis es nuestra capacidad para comprender la importancia de nuestras relaciones; especialmente aquellos que más necesitan nuestro cuidado. Nos recuerdan que no estamos hechos para el aislamiento como apoyamos a quienes más lo necesitan o aceptamos el apoyo de otros cuando lo necesitamos. Esta es la base de la confianza social: que en cualquier crisis, estemos preparados para estar al servicio de los demás. Aquellos que tienen estas características en mente pueden superar el caos o la crisis viviendo un momento a la vez y ocupándose de lo más importante.

La confianza es esencial para cualquier esfuerzo humano, pero especialmente cuando pretendemos trabajar juntos en cualquier proyecto. La pandemia ha obstaculizado los esfuerzos de muchos para trabajar juntos por el bien que podemos hacer en nuestra comunidad parroquial, esta ciudad de Campbell y nuestra región. No se sabe cuánto tiempo tendremos que permanecer vigilantes con respecto a la transmisibilidad, pero he discutido estos asuntos con el liderazgo parroquial y tenemos la intención de volver a involucrar a los miembros de esta comunidad a medida que avanzamos al otoño e invierno. Por eso estamos orando para que Dios nos ayude a llamar a voluntarios para que vuelvan a servir en la comunidad por el bien de todos.

To qualify, you must be a Santa Clara County resident who:

- ✓ Has been financially impacted by the pandemic;
- ✓ Is at-risk of losing your housing; AND
- ✓ Makes less than 30% of the area's median income (see income table to the right)

Eligible residents will receive assistance to help pay rent, and may also qualify for additional funds to meet other basic needs. The amount of assistance will be determined based on the individual household's situation and funding availability.

All eligible residents are encouraged to apply, and priority will go towards assisting the most vulnerable members of our community.

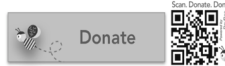

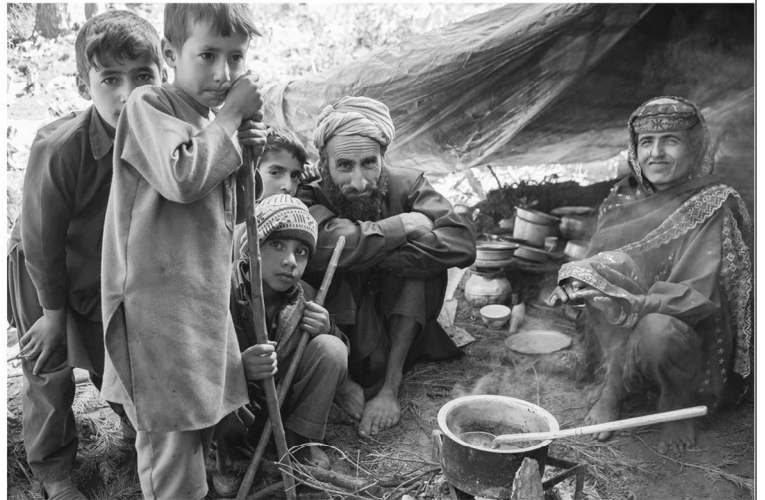

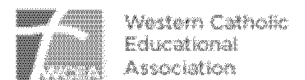
