### **Administration:**

1. Administration Commission will progress in our faith to become 'Intentional Disciples' through working on becoming a tithing parish and being good stewards of our physical and fiscal resources.
2. Pastoral Council Reps: Bob Dougherty and Steve Ciari

## **Worship:**

1. Leadership Staffing:
  - Terri Miller will continue for one more year as co-chair. Nobody has stepped up to co-chair.
  - Guillermina Buenrostro and Joan Milligan will continue as Pastoral Council Representatives.
2. Budget: A couple of small changes are needed to the budget. Terri will make the adjustments and re-submit to Raymond.
3. Worship Commission Plan for FY 2015-16: Terri submitted the Plan to Christy.
4. Bob Dougherty asked for a few minutes. He suggested recognizing people with “milestone anniversaries” at Masses once a month. The diocese does this for people with milestone wedding anniversaries, but not everybody wants to go there. It was noted that this is already being planned by the new Usher/Greeter Ministry.
5. There is a Ministerial Dinner hosted by St. Lucy Parish Staff on May 15. Mass at 6:00, BBQ dinner @ 7:00. If you are not already responding through another Ministry, please advise Terri if you’re going and if you are bringing a guest. Terri will advise Mari.
6. We spent the balance of the time discussing our 2015 – 2016 goals and appointing a sub-committee for each goal. All of our goals were set with the intention of Growing Intentional Disciples which is the Parish theme for this year. Our goals are:
  - Plan and Execute a ‘training Mass’
  - Provide parishioners with suggestions/materials for how they can spend additional time with God during the week (not just one hour per week at Mass)
  - Create and publish a resource listing for ministries under the Worship Commission umbrella
7. Father Steve noted that he is working on the notion of ‘discipleship groups’. Groups who would form to inspire each other and hold each other accountable for continuing activities that will help them grow in their discipleship (much like a group of folks who are working out together support each other in getting their workouts in).
8. Save the date: This year’s Seeker’s Retreat is scheduled for June 20.

## **Community Life:**

1. Members of the Commission continued to review and revise the Community Life Commission Plan Update for 2015-2016 and approved the final draft.
2. Report on the results included the Initial roll-out of the Rotunda Software, the 3rd Ministry Mingle, the 2nd Parish Picnic, and the establishment of the Hospitality Subcommittee to reinvigorate the Hospitality Ministry with special emphasis on enhanced Ushers/Greeters ministry.
3. Major Goals set for 2015-2016 include continuation of Ushers/Greeters project emphasizing recruitment and retention, communication, training and tracking. Second goal is to study and redefine our goals and objectives as they pertain to our relationship with ministries under our Commission to better serve them and the parish at large. The third goal for the upcoming year is to continue to implement and support annual events

- including Ministry Mingle, Picnic, social gatherings, faith formation retreats, etc. and supply volunteers.
4. The members also spent a great deal of time discussing the inclusion of the purchase of a wireless outside communication system and follow spot under the Comite Hispano budget. These would actually be useful for many parish events, celebrations and liturgies not limited to the Spanish speaking community including Posadas, Palm Sunday processions, Reenactment of the Passion, Holy Thursday Mass, Easter Vigil, youth activities and the picnic, to name some.
  5. The overall theme the Commission adopted for 2015-2016 is "Becoming Intentional Disciples" through Commission work in partnership with the ministries in the parish.

### **Pastoral Council Summary:**

1. St. Lucy Prayer Card is in progress and expected to be available for Pentecost. It will be in both Spanish and English.
2. Discussed St. Lucy Stewardship Strategy. Some highlights include:
  - Continue Budget transparency for both donations and spending
  - Continue Stewardship education
