Worship:

1. 2016-2017 goals
 - Monthly tips to provide parishioners with simple ideas on how to practice the 14 Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy – in this year of mercy that started in April.
 - Training guide and Process for Mass Coordinators will be available in July in Power Point format.
2. Review PAR Process – Highlights
 - Going Well
 - i. Monthly meetings – for leaders to come together, talk and find out what's going on.
 - ii. All ministries have a place to go once a month to get answers or information.
 - iii. Each commission has a liaison for each ministry to provide 2-way conversation.
 - iv. One central contact for each ministry.
 - v. Budget process helps ministries with planning disciplines. Think ahead and be proactive with their needs.
 - Needing Help
 - i. Lack of integration with non-English speaking communities – The most impactful being the Hispanic Community.
 - ii. Balancing between updating and planning. A few of us feel the meeting could be structured better to provide a balance between planners and doers; in a way that all members can contribute more.
 - iii. A few members thought 2 hours once a month was too much.

Community Life:

1. **Parish Picnic September 10th 2016:** Plans are underway and we'll be asking for volunteers after all Masses this weekend. It will also be possible to sign-up on-line via Rotunda, and a meeting for all the Parish Picnic co-chairs will be invited to a July 13th planning meeting.
2. **Health Fair August 27th 2016:** Plans are underway for our 2nd annual Health Fair and various organizations will be sponsoring the event including the American Red Cross,

BeTheMatch.org, Healthier Kids Foundation, Traffic Safety & Education and the CANP. It will be mentioned in the Campbell newspaper and on a local Spanish radio station to raise awareness of the event.

3. **Membership:** Each CLC member will invite a guest to the August 25th meeting.
4. **Pancake Breakfast August 7th:** The Knights of Columbus will be hosting a pancake breakfast in to raise funds for the youth who will be traveling in January to participate in the Walk for Life.

Pastoral Council Summary:
