

## Two Minute Summary Reports from St. Lucy Parish Commissions

July 24, 2014

### Administration:

1. Technology: Received a \$3,000 grant from Catholic foundation
2. Next Step: Decide how to use this fund for audio visual TVs
3. Stewardship - Prioritized Projects:
  - A. Priorities
    1. E-news – Published monthly since May. Looking for an Editor.
    2. Annual Stewardship (Talent, Time, Treasure) Commitment Forms – Nov.
    3. Web Upgrade- Oct.
    4. ADA – Need a short term volunteer to help for 10 weeks
  - B. Priorities
    1. Happy Meter on Annual St. Lucy survey – Sep.
    2. Registration Events – (New update for Parishioners and Parish Pay) – Oct.
4. Finance: Looking for financial experts to relieve Bob D. Require about a couple hours/quarterly.
