GOSPEL MEDITATION

I eat breakfast. If I don't have something substantial, I'm fading by midmorning. Breakfast is my key meal because it sets up my physical wellbeing for the rest of the day.

Spiritually speaking, we need sustenance to get us going. This is true for the Apostles in this Sunday's remarkable Gospel reading. The risen Jesus makes his third appearance to them in the early morning light and calls, "Come, have breakfast" (John 21:12). The exhausted and cold fishermen sit, and he feeds them bread and fish as the dawn breaks. They are overwhelmed by his presence to the point of awestruck silence. As they eat, their bodies and their hearts come alive. Once refreshed by their morning meal, they will be ready to feed others — indeed, the whole world — with the love of the risen Jesus. But first, they need breakfast from him.

Do you realize how essential early morning prayer is? Jesus desires to refresh us every morning with his word of love, with his grace-filled presence. This week, hear Jesus calling to you: "Come, have breakfast!" Embrace some form of spiritual, meditative practice each morning for spiritual strength to get you going. — Father John Muir ©LPI

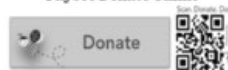

SVDP / Outreach Corner Oficina de Servicios Sociales

The St. Vincent de Paul Conference of St. Lucy Parish semi-annual report of services provided are as follows: There was a total of 178 clients seen from October 1 – March 31, 2025. Of those clients, 145 were housed and 33 were unhoused. Those clients visited the outreach office for a total of 442 visits. Those visits consisted of the distribution of food vouchers worth \$6,165 and bags of food worth \$11,015. In addition to the vouchers and food bags, 34 clients were provided rental assistance worth \$32,566 and 3 clients were provided utility assistance worth \$600. The number of adults (302) and children (161) include all persons impacted by the distribution of these services.

El informe semestral de servicios prestados por nuestra oficina es el siguiente: Se atendió a un total de 178 clientes entre el 1 de octubre y el 31 de marzo de 2025. De estos clientes, 145 tenían vivienda y 33 no. Acudieron a la oficina un total de 442 visitas. Estas visitas consistieron en la distribución de cupones de alimentos por un valor de \$6,165 y bolsas de alimentos por un valor de \$11,015. Además de los cupones y las bolsas de alimentos, 34 clientes recibieron asistencia para la renta por un valor de \$32,566 y 3 clientes recibieron asistencia para los servicios públicos por un valor de \$600. El número de adultos (302) y niños (161) incluye a todas las personas afectadas por la distribución de estos servicios.

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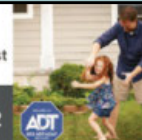


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
