

Ja, Ma Non Ancora

The Italian phrase *ja, ma non ancora* translates into English as already, but not yet. It expresses a paradox we all experience: something is present and real, and yet not fully realized. The wisdom of this phrase echoes throughout the Hebrew Scriptures and Christian texts, where God's people discovered that the gift of divine life was already theirs, though never completely perceived or understood. In faith, we too share in this divine life—already, but not yet.

This “not yet” is itself a blessing. If we fully grasped who we are and all that God calls us to be, there would be no room for discovery, learning, or growth. Instead, our human restlessness keeps us searching, asking, and striving. No doubt this same longing will also lead to challenges beyond our control. We wrestle with age-old questions: How can we live in harmony with one another and with creation? Can hunger and poverty ever truly end? Is peace through dialogue a more effective means than violence? How can we use the earth's resources responsibly and share them fairly without destroying our planet or amassing riches for a certain few?

These questions rarely yield simple or permanent answers. What matters more than the answers themselves is our faithful journey toward them. We grow by walking in faith, even when the destination feels far away. That journey itself is part of the “already,” and each step we take moves us closer to the “not yet.”

We see how this paradox evokes our Christian imagination. Consider the Kingdom of God: every time we pray, “Thy Kingdom come,” we acknowledge both what is here and what is still to come. We ask for daily bread, and sometimes we fail to live up to the forgiveness we pray for. Yet the possibility remains that each day we can grow into the Kingdom already present in our midst. The Kingdom is real, because we are already children of God and our sins are already forgiven—yet there is still more to learn.

The Creed gives us another example: “We believe in one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.” In baptism, forgiveness is already ours. And yet, we recognize our ongoing need for forgiveness each day. This tension between what is already and what is not yet is not a flaw in our faith, but its strength. It reminds us that God's gift is both real and still unfolding.

To live in this paradox is to live with hope. It means we are never finished, never beyond growth, never cut off from grace. Already, God has given us everything. And yet, God invites us to grow into it, one day at a time.

Ja, Ma Non Ancora

La frase italiana «ja, ma non ancora» se traduce al español como «ya, pero todavía no». Expresa una paradoja que todos experimentamos: algo está presente y es real, pero aún no se ha realizado plenamente. La sabiduría de esta frase resuena en las Escrituras hebreas y los textos cristianos, donde el pueblo de Dios descubrió que el don de la vida divina ya era suyo, aunque nunca lo percibiera ni comprendiera completamente. En la fe, nosotros también compartimos esta vida divina: «ya, pero todavía no».

Este «todavía no» es en sí mismo una bendición. Si comprendiéramos plenamente quiénes somos y todo lo que Dios nos llama a ser, no habría espacio para el descubrimiento, el aprendizaje ni el crecimiento. En cambio, nuestra inquietud humana nos mantiene buscando, preguntando y esforzándonos. Sin duda, este mismo anhelo también nos llevará a desafíos que escapan a nuestro control. Nos enfrentamos a preguntas ancestrales: ¿Cómo podemos vivir en armonía unos con otros y con la creación? ¿Pueden erradicar el hambre y la pobreza? ¿Es la paz a través del diálogo un medio más eficaz que la violencia? ¿Cómo podemos usar los recursos de la tierra responsablemente y compartirlos equitativamente sin destruir nuestro planeta ni acumular riquezas para unos pocos?

Estas preguntas rara vez ofrecen respuestas sencillas o permanentes. Lo que importa más que las respuestas mismas es nuestro camino fiel hacia ellas. Creemos caminando en la fe, incluso cuando el destino se siente lejano. Ese camino en sí mismo forma parte del «ya», y cada paso que damos nos acerca al «todavía no».

Vemos cómo esta paradoja evoca nuestra imaginación cristiana. Pensemos en el Reino de Dios: cada vez que oramos: «Venga tu Reino», reconocemos tanto lo que está aquí como lo que está por venir. Pedimos el pan de cada día, y a veces no estamos a la altura del perdón que pedimos. Sin embargo, existe la posibilidad de que cada día crezcamos en el Reino ya presente entre nosotros. El Reino es real, porque ya somos hijos de Dios y nuestros pecados ya están perdonados; sin embargo, aún hay más que aprender.

El Credo nos da otro ejemplo: «Creemos en un solo bautismo para el perdón de los pecados». En el bautismo, el perdón ya es nuestro. Y, sin embargo, reconocemos nuestra constante necesidad de perdón cada día. Esta tensión entre lo que ya es y lo que aún no es no es una falla en nuestra fe, sino su fortaleza. Nos recuerda que el don de Dios es real y aún está en desarrollo.

Vivir en esta paradoja es vivir con esperanza. Significa que nunca estamos acabados, nunca estamos incapaces de crecer, nunca estamos separados de la gracia. Dios ya nos lo ha dado todo. Y, sin embargo, Dios nos invita a crecer en él, día a día.


